Both the Geneva and Lyon international airports are within a 90-minute drive away. The nearest village is 2 km away and has quaint village living with bakeries, charcuteries and a weekly farmer's market and grocery stores. The chateau is the ideal place to enjoy the typical French lifestyle and escape a hectic city life. Some may prefer to enjoy adventure, shopping and exploring in cities such as Chambéry, Albertville and Annecy are only a short drive away.
