The magnificent Château d'Aleny is in the heart of beautiful Burgundy, near some of France's very best vineyards. With glorious gardens and furnished to a beautiful standard, this magical place is ideal for the perfect wedding or simply a memorable holiday in this captivating region.

Dating back to the 18th Century, the chateau has been lovingly renovated by well-known designers and the result is a classical home with modern and high-end features. Antique furnishings, traditional fireplaces and original features throughout complement contemporary touches such as the state-of-the-art kitchen, individually styled bedrooms and modern bathrooms, including a wonderful suite ideal for a bridal couple.

Modern amenities include heating throughout, making it an ideal place all year round, as well as super-fast Wi-Fi and Satellite TV. This said, most of the time you will be wanting to make the most of the glorious grounds, 40 hectares of private parkland featuring woods as well as French style gardens. The more energetic guests can play tennis in the new courts or dip into the 16m long swimming pool overlooking the grounds.

The private chapel on the grounds is a picturesque place to get married whilst receptions can take place in the gardens or inside the Orangery. With a wedding planner linked to the chateau, Oliver's Travels can advise you on all the details needed to plan your romantic Burgundy wedding.

Interior & Grounds

Chateau d'Aleny has recently been refurbished to allow the perfect blend of antique furnishings and style alongside more modern design and features. Facilities include super-fast Wi-Fi, satellite TV (including Netflix, sports channels and international channels).

Light fills the 18th century reception rooms due to the high ceilings and large windows, filled with furnishings reminiscent of this period.

The well-equipped and contemporary kitchen has equipment suitable for a professional kitchen and a chef can be hired to serve lunch either by the pool or in one of the dining rooms, including one with a table for up to 25 guests and an additional one for children or extra guests.

There are 17 bedrooms, which can sleep up to 34 guests and they all include new beds which are very comfortable. They include a particularly lavish honeymoon suite room of 40m² with 4m high ceilings and an emperor double bed (200x200). Two cots and baby equipment can be provided on request.

Outside, there is 40 hectares of parkland with fields, woods and gardens. Guests may organise activities in advance such as shooting and there is a new tennis court and Weber BBQ.

The swimming pool (16mx5m) has a safety-cover and the pool house features a kitchenette and shower room.

Location & Local Information

Chateau d'Aleny is situated in Burgundy, only 40-minutes from Beaune and the famous vineyards of the Côte-d'Or.

Beaune, the wine-capital of the region, is 36km away. Visit the amazing Hospices de Beaune, one of France's most stunning historical buildings and don't miss the great market on Wednesday and Saturday mornings. Food-lovers should also try and get to one of the thirty Michelin starred establishments in the town and surrounding wine villages, including Maison Lameloise, a 100-year old restaurant with 3 Michelin stars in Chagny, also a forty-minute drive away.

In this area you can discover world-famous vineyards and sample the very finest wines from the Côte de Beaune and Côte de Nuits appellations. Explore some of the idyllic villages of the Route des Grands Crus such as Puligny-Montrachet, Pommard and Meursault, all within an hour's drive.

Alternatively, stay closer to home where you can play golf, ride horses and hike through the spectacular scenery or visit pretty local villages, towns and chateaux. The local rivers are also great places for watersports or just a perfect picnic in serene surroundings.

There are many local farms where you can pick up high-quality organic local produce and excellent restaurants to visit. The guidebook especially created in Chateau d'Aleny will give lots of good information about places to visit nearby. Guests can also arrange wine-tasting at the chateau with a specialist wine-connoisseur.

Chalon-sur-Saône and Jura are both fantastic places worthy of visiting, not forgetting the beautiful and historic city of Dijon, only an hour away.

The nearest international airports are Lyon or Geneva. The nearest train station is 12km from the chateau (in Seurre) which has direct trains to Dijon (which has high-speed connections to Paris). Alternatively, driving from Paris (350km) takes around 3.5 hours.

- Departure time: All bedrooms must be vacated by 11.00 a.m. Check out time is flexible. Please enquire.
- Energy costs included?: Included in the rental price.
- Linen & towels included?: All linen and towels are included in the rental price. Linens and towels are changed every Saturday and mid-week.
- Pets welcome?: Pets allowed.
- Changeover day: Any day of the week.
- Smoking Allowed?: No smoking indoors.
- Insurance: It is recommended that all guests take out insurance to cover against potential cancellation and any accidental damage caused during your stay at the property.

- End of stay cleaning included?: No. Cleaning fees are charged at an extra cost and are to be paid on site to the owner. The amount should be advised to you at the time of quoting. This covers the full cleaning of the chateau before arrival and at end of your stay as well as a brief daily maid service of the bedrooms (emptying the rubbish and changing bed linen mid-week).
- Other Ts and Cs: Full service is mandatory during peak season. Outside the peak season, self-catering is possible (except for weddings) and you can also book the cook and maid service on a per-day or per-meal basis.
- Minimum stay: From May to end of September: 3 nights. From October to March: 2 nights for holidays, 3 nights for weddings.
