Overview

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: If guests are on a board option (half or all-in), credit card details are asked as guaranteed. If guests wish to make use of the kitchen or hire external caterers, there is a deposit of €500 to be paid on arrival
- Arrival time: 3pm
- Departure time: 12pm (noon)
- End of stay cleaning included?: For self-catering use and external caterers, we ask for a cleaning fee of 50€ by the end of your stay. For guests on a board option, end of stay cleaning fee is included
- Linen & towels included?: Bed linen, bath and pool towels are included in the rental price.
- Energy costs included?: Yes, included in rental price.
- Internet access?: The property has complimentary Wi-fi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- Minimum stay: 3 nights in low season, 5 nights in high season
- Changeover day: Flexible
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed
- Smoking Allowed?: Not permitted
- Pool heating charge?: There is no pool heating available
- Insurance: Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, public liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- Other Ts and Cs: When minimum occupancy is booked, certain rooms may not be accessible (subject to owner's discretion) - best to enquire with us beforehand
