## Overview

The first floor harbours the expansive parental suite, a perennial guest favourite. This suite comprises a charming Moroccan-style living space and a generously sized terrace adorned with outdoor seating, commanding views of the pool and garden. The en-suite bathroom is a marvel, featuring a striking windowed wall that permits simultaneous indulgence in a bath and a captivating sunset panorama. Adjacent to this suite are two equally well-appointed en-suite bedrooms. An additional trio of bedrooms on the ground floor offer direct access to the garden, seamlessly merging indoor comfort with outdoor serenity. For further accommodations, a loft situated in the garden features two supplementary twin beds in conjunction with the main room.

The garden is thoughtfully landscaped to facilitate tranquil morning strolls, allowing toes to sink into the grass while savouring a warm cup of Moroccan tea beneath the sheltering embrace of tall palm trees and sun shades—the exterior pool beckons. A shallow sun shelf caters to young swimmers, while the pool's length accommodates those inclined towards laps. Alternatively, the interior pool, equipped with a counter-current, stands ready to offer a more rigorous aquatic workout.
