The Costa Blanca coastline is one of the most stunning, picturesque spots offering something for every holiday goer. Most importantly, the weather is beautiful and the area welcomes 3,000 hours of sun a year and the average afternoon high year-round is 20 degrees.

One of the most popular towns along the coast because of its stunning architecture and incredible history is the medieval town of Benissa. The town's rich history has been largely preserved. As you wander the narrow lanes be fully immersed in the medieval character that still exists in Benissa, the white walls, window grids and flowers that hang from the balconies.

Of course, there are also stunning beaches along the coast with crystal clear water and EEC flags, which mean the beaches are not only clean but also safe and accessible.

Benissa boasts fresh, locally caught seafood, which is a must try. There are also plenty of international establishments in the area, so every appetite is happy no matter what they fancy.

Take a day trip along the coast to other towns and be charmed by the upmarket beach town of Moraira or engross yourself in more history at Calpe, a town full of Mudejar-Gothic architecture. All of this is a breeze as Benissa is located just off the A-7 motorway. The nearest airport, Alicante, is just over an hour's drive from the villa and the second nearest airport, Valencia, is over 100 kilometres away.
