

If you enjoy fishing, you're also within walking distance of a popular fishing spot.

From Muz Evi, you can walk 6km into Marmaris, or there's a local dolmus (minibus) service which passes just 250 metres from the villa and runs between 8 am and 10 pm. Taxis cost around £15 one way and drivers are reachable by texting or phoning. If you prefer, owners at the villa can arrange car hire.

In Marmaris centre, you'll find plenty of restaurants, shops and bars. You can stroll along the harbour lined with high-end yachts, haggle for local honey, traditional rugs or designer copies in the bazaar, or try the local cuisine. Look out for fresh seafood and meat kebabs. Marmaris also boasts a 16th-century

castle and an archaeology museum with underwater excavated treasures that are worth a visit.

Nestling on the cusp of the Aegean and Mediterranean Seas, you'll also find plenty of sandy swimming beaches in Marmaris and opportunity to go on diving trips to underwater caves (Marmaris boasts 52 top-notch diving spots). Charter-boat tours can whisk you to Dalyan or spots on the Bozburun Peninsula. Water sports such as scuba diving, jet-skiing and paragliding are favourites, or for a fun family-friendly day trip there's a couple of water parks with slides and pools.

- During winter months (1st November to 31st March) the villa is long term rentals only, minimum 1 month.

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: A £300/€300 deposit will be taken in resort to secure against any damages
- Arrival time: Check in is from 14:00 onwards
- Departure time: Check out is 11:00 or earlier
- Energy costs included?: Yes, included in the rental price
- Linen & towels included?: Linen, pestamel wraps and towels are included in the rental price. The linen & towels are changed at twice a week (including arrival/ departure day)
- End of stay cleaning included?: Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- Internet access?: Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on the local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- Minimum stay: 5 nights. All other durations on request.
- Changeover day: Flexible
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed
- Smoking Allowed?: Smoking & Vaping are not permitted.
- Internet access?: Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, loss of personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- Pool opening dates?: The pool & whirlpool are not operational in winter months, November-1st April. There is also no mid week clean during this time.
- Other Ts and Cs: There is a 50% discount for children between 3 and 12 and babies are free of charge.
- Other 2: Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- Other 3: In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases, a bathroom bin is provided.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government [Website](#) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
