Opportunities for aquatic revelry abound: a private al fresco swimming pool beckons, while the nearby Belcekiz beach and the Oludeniz Nature Reserve and beach await a short jaunt away. An embrace of rustic stone walls and towering foliage envelops the villa, safeguarding your privacy and cocooning you in tranquillity. The open-air veranda is graced with cushioned sun loungers and potted resplendent bougainvillea blossoms. Whether you seek a shaded nook for leisurely reading or a refreshing dip in the crystalline azure waters, the terrace caters to your desires. As night falls, lanterns embedded within the walls cast a gentle glow, prolonging the serenity well into the evening hours.

Step within to encounter an interior exuding modernity and sophistication, as light grey walls harmonize with earth-toned furnishings. Two capacious bathrooms showcase sleek stainless steel fixtures and marble-grey tiles, complemented by generous mirrors and plush towels for a homely touch. The villa additionally boasts a convivial open-plan living space, marrying the kitchen and dining areas. With comfortable seating, a dining table, and a fully equipped culinary haven, complete with an oven and microwave, this space accommodates every need. Savour meals indoors or beneath the sheltered al fresco tableau, both affording a chance to soak in the enchanting panoramas. An outdoor grill and seating enclave await, ideal for culinary adventures and relaxation alike.

Location & Local Information

Nestled upon the picturesque coast of Seven Capes in Faralya, Vila Faralya extends a welcoming hand, providing a haven of tranquility a mere 12km distant from the bustling Oludeniz resort and a leisurely 25km away from the lively city of Fethiye. The villa's perch grants sweeping vistas of the enchanting Butterfly Valley, replete with its sandy shore and idyllic strolls along a verdant ravine, where one might chance upon two concealed waterfalls.


This realm is a utopia for avid ramblers, as it lies in proximity to portions of the renowned Lycian Way trail. This scenic path meanders through towering pine groves, olive orchards, fields ablaze with wildflowers, and the humble abodes of shepherds, affording unassuming yet picturesque lodgings by the coastline. Of notable allurements along this path are the enigmatic Kayaköy ghost village and the ancient enclave of Tlos, which bestows breathtaking vistas overlooking the valley of Xanthos.

For those yearning for repose, the Oludeniz Blue Lagoon, a mere 7km distant, presents a tranquil haven of natural beauty, its beach kissed by crystal-clear waters, a veritable sanctuary for swimming and snorkelling. The precinct offers a spectrum of aquatic pursuits, including canoeing, paragliding, and pedalo rides, all set against the backdrop of snug cafes that proffer refreshments. Furthermore, the sandy expanse of Belcekiz beach, framed by the majestic Bagadag mountains, lies a short 6.5km drive from the embrace of Villa Faralya.

A sojourn to Fethiye town beckons as a highly recommended indulgence, affording a taste of authentic Turkish culture. Wander through the cobbled lanes of the old quarter, where mosques and a medley of boutiques peddle handcrafted ceramics, jewellery, leather finery, and sumptuous carpets. The marina extends a serene ambiance, its waters dotted with glimmering yachts, offering the perfect setting to savour Turkish cuisine or partake in a refreshing libation. And for an added touch of luxury, why not pamper oneself with the invigorating experience of a Turkish bath?

What we love

- Brilliant location in a rural setting surrounded by beautiful nature.
- Butterfly Valley with its soft sandy beach, gorge walks with waterfalls and diverse butterfly species is definitely worth a visit and is only 1.2km from your front door.

- The fabulous Olu Deniz is a short drive away, restaurants, shops, a lovely beach and the much photographed lagoon that has many beach clubs surrounding it.

What you should know...

- The villa is sitting pretty in the hillside and is on a slight incline so shoes with a good grip could be useful.
- The location of the villa means that a car is a necessity to reach local attractions and the nearest beaches in Oludeniz. Faralya is a beautiful area, enhanced by it's cliff-top position. The approaching road can be difficult for even the most experienced driver, especially in the dark. We'd say a car is essential but recommend booking a transfer from the airport and having the car delivered to the villa

- Arrival time: Check in 14:00 onwards
- Departure time: Checkout time is 10:30 or earlier
- Energy costs included?: Yes all energy costs are included in the rental price.
- Linen & towels included?: Linen and towels are included in the rental charge.
- Security deposit: £200 to be paid in cash, upon arrival
- Other Ts and Cs: Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- Other 2: In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- End of stay cleaning included?: End of stay clean is included in the price, the villa is cleaned 3 times a week (includes arrival day).
- Internet access?: The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- Insurance: It is recommended that all guests take out insurance to cover against potential cancellation, personal accidents and any accidental damage caused during your stay at the property.
- Smoking Allowed?: Sorry, smoking are requested not to smoke inside the villa.
- Changeover day: Flexible
- Minimum stay: 7 nights
- Pets welcome?: Sorry pets are not welcome at the property.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government [Website](#) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
