Overview

Are you dreaming of a luxury holiday? Kisla Prime – a modern, four-bedroom villa overlooking sweeping Kalkan Bay in Turkey – is your go-to. This contemporary villa flaunts a large infinity pool with prime sea views, as well as top-notch facilities including a fully-equipped kitchen. The décor throughout is elegant and to a very high standard, with marble floors and a crisp and refreshing colour palette. Plus, bustling Kalkan Town with its soft, sandy beaches is only a short five-minute drive away.

Thanks to the large pool and garden area – dotted with sun loungers and chairs – there are plenty of places for you to relax. And when you want some cooling reprieve, head for one of the shaded spots or inside where cooling air conditioning awaits. Doors from the terrace lead straight into the spacious, open-plan living, kitchen and dining room, equipped with a comfy sofa. There's also a dining table and everything you'll need for a self-catering stay and more from a washing machine to a dishwasher. Or, if you prefer you can dine alfresco on the terrace, with those coastal views.

The four double bedrooms, across the first and second floors, are all equally stylish, and have large windows or doors letting in the beautiful natural light. They all boast en-suite bathrooms with walk-in showers, as well as walk-in wardrobes and balconies. On the third floor, there's also a table-equipped roof terrace where you can sip wine while watching a sunset and another bathroom.

If you'd like to go exploring, you're well placed to explore this beautiful part of Turkey. Make a beeline for one of the beach clubs or into Kalkan Town with its boat-dotted harbour, quaint streets lined with houses and shops, and the town's famous markets and rooftop restaurants.

Location & Local Information


Kisla Prime is a short, 5-minute drive from Kalkan – a vibrant Turkish town known for its charming character, stunning architecture and striking natural scenery. With a peaceful and welcoming atmosphere and plenty of things to do and see it is an ideal choice for families and couples alike.

Kalkan is at the foot of the Taurus mountains, and so there are plenty of fantastic walking, biking and hiking routes. Most people use the old fishing village, turned popular holiday destination, as a base to visit the nearby Lycian ruins – interesting ancient sites – or engage in the many local activities. You can't come to this beautiful part of Turkey without exploring Xanthos, Patara and Myra.

In the town, you can visit one of the bustling markets where you'll find everything from spices to hand-made rugs, produce and jewellery or browse the boutique shops. Look out for stalls selling fresh gozleme (savoury pancakes). Stop off for a drink and bite to eat at one of the waterfront cafes or famous roof-top restaurants, offering fantastic food and unrivalled views of the bay.

In Kalkan, you can also take your pick from a selection of stunning golden beaches. There's Kalkan beach near the marina, and Kaputas, a scenic sandy cove about 7km east of Kalkan or Patara Beach, which is also a National Park. Most of the beaches have beach clubs which offer sports like sea kayaking, scuba diving and parasailing and have decking for lounging and restaurants.

For more aquatic adventures, you can jump on a traditional boat from Kalkan harbour to explore the surrounding bays and coves. Boats also leave Kas (a 30-minute drive away) to the island of Kekova where there are half-submerged ancient 2nd-century ruins. The whole family can discover them via swimming, snorkelling or sea kayaking.

What we love

- Fantastic Kalkan Bay views from any of the bedrooms and balconies, as well as the roof terrace and pool terrace.
- The facilities here are fantastic – including an outdoor infinity pool, fully-equipped kitchen with a Gaggia espresso machine so you can bring your favourite coffee to enjoy.
- The sea, local restaurant and beach club are all a short stroll from the villa, and vibrant Kalkan town is a short 5-minute drive away. Perfect if you like a morning dip.
- There is the option of a bread and grocery delivery every morning (goods charged as extra)

What you should know...

- It's good to note the villa is on an incline and has 26 steps up so not suitable for those with limited mobility.
- Although you can walk to the beach, local shop and restaurant, a car would be great to explore more such as Saklikent Gorge, Patara & Kas. Local taxis are reasonably priced too.
- For winter stays there is heating and duvets for the beds. The pool isn't heated but the sea is an ok swimming temperature late into the year.
- Solar heated water

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: £500 damage deposit to be paid on arrival
- End of stay cleaning included?: End of stay clean is included in the price. For two week guests the villa will be cleaned mid stay.
- Other Ts and Cs: A welcome pack is supplied including bottle of wine, beer and nibbles
- Other 2: In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- Other 3: Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- Internet access?: The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government [Website](#) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
