Chalet Machrie is a sleek and contemporary chalet apartment, brimming with all the authentic, yet polished, charm of a modern ski lodge. Set in the heart of prestigious resort, Val d'Isère, it offers a sumptuous base, along with a whole host of pampering extras and services for those who wish for a seamless, hassle-free stay.

Set within a traditional style chalet building, it is on the second floor (accessible via lift), and boasts the comfort of being host staffed, as well as offering full catering to the highest standard, including welcome champagne, pre-dinner canapés and three course meals complemented by wine. For those who wish to arrive, rejuvenate, and focus on world-class skiing, in the knowledge that they have a pristine base to return to, this abode has it covered.

This delightful apartment style rental epitomises the ultimate Nordic “hygge” effect - cosy and warming, yet with a luxurious spin - it offers a private sauna, terrace and log-burning fire.

Executed impeccably with ‘chalet-chic’ styling, it offers a timber-clad interior using locally sourced materials. A stunning open-plan living room, dining space and kitchen sets the scene for lively group time, whether it be convening at the end of the day over a delectable meal, or curling up by the fire with a game of cards. With contemporary light fittings and splashes of pillar-box red, faux fur and designer flair, this is more than just another chalet - it offers a little interiors panache along with a cosy, authentic feel.

Exposed wooden ceilings and a very Scandinavian style layout, along with carefully chosen textured fabrics (faux fur rugs, jacquard cushions) and low-hanging lighting will bring a smile to guests' faces. Eight guests can be accommodated across four impeccably styled bedrooms, featuring crisp quality cotton linen, fluffy towels and en-suites with luxury toiletries.

Chalet Machrie is all about location. Set in a beautiful new complex in the heart of Val d'Isère, this apartment enjoys proximity to excellently maintained slopes and ski infrastructures, as well as bustling village life. The centre of Val d'Isère is where the heart of the resort lies; the beautiful high street offers traditional buildings and magnificent surrounding mountains. Stretching to three miles, the “old town” is where the 17th century church St Bernard is



found. Known for offering one of the longest snow seasons, and with ski kudos amongst competitive events, Val d'Isère boasts an impressive 300 km of pistes and 78 lifts.

A buzzing and vibrant winter retreat, Val d'Isère offers up-scale boutiques, restaurants and bars, and intricate ice sculptures can often be seen dotted around the pavements. Two main ski areas are a five minutes walk away, whilst the regular bus service from the Rond Point takes visitors to La Daille and to Le Fornet within minutes, meaning excellent connections and easy access to an array of world-class slopes.

Location & Local Information

Chalet Machrie is nestled in the centre of Val d'Isère; set in the heart of this charming village it could not be better located. Val d'Isère is in the Savoie region of the French Alps, approaching the Italian border. With the high street so near and a five minute stroll to the main ski lifts, this is a skiers's dream. Val d'Isère, which connects to the neighbouring Tignes, is especially popular among Brits, and is known for having one of the longest ski seasons

The three mile long village, set within the valley, stretches from the "old town" with its medieval Church, to the bustling high street with its ups-scale boutiques, buzzing après-ski bars and restaurants, the streets often lined with intricate ice-sculptures during the winter months. With beautiful views of the surrounding mountains, traditional stone and wood buildings, this village has an authentic feel along with a cosmopolitan buzz. The nightlife scene has everything from refined bars, to dancing-on-tables establishments.

Val d'Isère caters for all levels, from beginners to experienced off-piste skiers. With an excellent infrastructure, the Solaise gondola was updated for the 2017 season, with a state-of-the-art lift, the new 10 person gondola complex complete with heated seats and wifi. The legendary Face de Belvedere is a black-rated piste, designed for the 1992 Olympics, it has a 915 metre drop. Home to a number of ski and snowboard events each year, one of the best known being the Critérium de la Première Neige, a Federation Internationale de Ski (FIS) competition in mid-December that has been running since 1955.
