Location & Local Information

This gorgeous home is nestled on Sicily's beautiful southern coast, on the outskirts of Licata. Walk a few minutes to reach the nearest beach, popular for its soft golden sand and clear water that is perfect for snorkelling. When you fancy a bite to eat, there is a wide selection of restaurants near the villa and along the seafront.

You'll find more restaurants and a wide range of bars in the centre of Licata, a seaport town with a blissful coastline. Visit Rocca San Nicola, a picturesque shore which sits opposite an incredible rock formation. Another slice of paradise is Cala Paradiso, a serene beach surrounded by huge cliff faces and filled with polished stones. When you're not relaxing by the seaside, make sure you explore the city's in-depth past. Castel Sant'Angelo, Torre San Nicola and the Archaeological Museum are just some of the sites worth visiting.

Sat upon a hilltop, Agrigento is a fascinating city with a rich history. Explore the Valley of Temples, a listed UNESCO World Heritage site which provides an insight into Greek art and archaeology. There are many ancient buildings, temples and a few museums dotted around the city, where you can learn more about the local history. Filled with several eateries, bars and beaches, this city has something for everyone.

Its diverse landscape is dotted with interesting places like the seaside town of Sciacca and the stunning commune of Piazza Armerina. - Energy costs included?: Included up to 200 kWh per week - Extra consumption fee of € 0.40 per kWh payable locally.
- Linen & towels included?: Yes, linen changed weekly and towels changed mid week.
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed.
- Changeover day: Saturday approximately end-June to end-August. Flexible during all other periods.
- End of stay cleaning included?: Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- Smoking Allowed?: Outside only.
- Insurance: It is recommended that all guests take out insurance to cover against potential cancellation and any accidental damage caused during your stay at the property.
- Minimum stay: 7 nights.
- Heating costs included?: No, on consumption.

- Pool opening dates?: The pool is open approximately end March to beginning of November. Please note that pool opening dates are subject to local weather conditions and pool maintenance requirements and that cooler months may not be suitable for swimming.
