Overview

Located on the outskirts of Ayia Napa, just a ten-minute walk from the beautiful Ayia Thekla beach, you can enjoy the peace and quiet of your own private accommodation as well as the lively atmosphere that Cyprus is known for.

Throughout the villa, the design has been made to reflect the beautiful surroundings, with pale blue walls that imitate the calming colour of the sky, whilst the windows form picture frames around the breath-taking sea views.

Downstairs the main living space is open-plan, with sunlight streaming in through every opening, enlivening the space with natural light. You can sit in the comfort of a sofa gazing out at the sea on the horizon, or dine together with your loved ones, opening the back doors to create the illusion of being outside. The intimate kitchen is in the corner, fully-equipped and offering more charming views out across the luscious surroundings.

The bedrooms can be found on the upper floor, including a beautiful double room with doors out to an elegant balcony. The balcony is perfect for evening drinks, watching the sky change colour as the sun sets each evening and enjoying the fresh sea breeze that blows in from the Mediterranean. There is also a second double and a kid's room with bunk beds, both of which also have picturesque views.

Out under the warm sun, Villa Columba boasts beautiful living areas, with a spacious terrace and luscious garden surrounding the villa's walls. The private swimming pool can be enjoyed by kids and adults alike, cooling off from the midday sun, and relaxing after busy days exploring Cyprus. Location & Local Information

Famous for its stunning sandy beaches, turquoise waters, picturesque landscapes and halloumi cheese, Cyprus is a fabulous holiday destination for a relaxing breakaway. Villa Columba is located on the outskirts of Ayia Napa, just a 10-minute walk to Ayia Thekla Beach and less than a 5-minute drive to the resort centre. The villa itself sits in a quiet cul-de-sac, perfect for families looking for peace and quiet yet remaining nearby all the amenities of the town.

Ayia Napa is known for its rich history and culture as well as its bustling, lively atmosphere. Bursting with busy restaurants, folklore bars and an animated nightlife, the town suits both families and groups of friends looking to enjoy the busy side of island life. Located on the south-eastern coast of Cyprus, the town is bursting with rich history and culture, with an ancient monastery and medieval church, constructed from honey-coloured limestone, with Byzantine influences found throughout the architecture. When it comes to eating out, try ordering a mezze platter with various local delicacies so you can try a bit of everything! The sweet baklava for pudding is also a must-try during your stay!

With Ayia Thekla Beach just a short walk from your front door it becomes a firm favourite for our guests. With the turquoise sea lapping at its golden sandy shore and the ancient church that is its namesake behind, the setting feels completely relaxing and tranquil. The Cyprus coastline is dotted with stunning beaches, some of which are quiet and peaceful, whilst others boast exhilarating water sports and even the chance to try scuba diving or sea kayaking. Nissi beach, also nearby the villa, is famous for its water sports and scuba diving, perfect for energetic kids and adventurous adults!

Inland, the island is scattered with vineyards, pine trees and wildflower meadows, a welcome contrast to the sandy beaches. At Cape Greco National Park you can enjoy hiking and mountain biking, seeing the landscapes ever-changing natures as you rush past on two wheels! A day trip to Paphos is always popular, where you can swim around Aphrodite's Rock, known as the spiritual home of the Greek goddess of love.
