Riverside Manor is situated in the small village of Newington, the neighbouring village of Stadhampton, home to the iconic Crazy Bear Hotel & Restaurant, is less than a 5-minute drive away. The historic market town of Wallingford, which boasts a wider selection of helpful amenities, is just a 10-minute drive away. The thriving city of Oxford, best known for its prestigious University, is just 25-minutes from the Manor and is a must-visit, with plenty for visitors to see and explore!

In the wider area, there are plenty of attractions for the whole family to enjoy. To the North is the beautiful Cotswolds region, designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, this area is home to a number of quintessentially-English towns and villages with pretty honey-coloured stone buildings. A number of the best-known destinations including Chipping Norton, Stow-on-the-Wold, and Bourton-on-the-Water are all within an hour's drive, while Bicester Village is just a 30-minute drive away and is a must-visit for any keen shopaholics. To the South, are the Chilterns and the popular town of Henley-on-Thames which is less than 30-minutes away, while Windsor, known for its iconic Castle, is a 50-minute drive.
