

Angsana Sea View Pool Villa

Overview

Escape to the Elysian fields of the Corfu countryside when you stay at the luxury Angsana Sea View Pool Villa. This one-bedroom private pool villa has stunning views of the Ionian Sea and can accommodate up to three guests. The contemporary villa is situated on the ground floor of a larger hotel and villa complex in the exclusive Angsana Resort, and is the perfect place for couples and honeymooners to enjoy a holiday on the idyllic island of Corfu. The villa comes with the services of a five star hotel, a twenty-four hour front desk and concierge, and room service on call. The resort is built in the style of the local Venetian architecture of the historical homes, whilst the villas are decorated with rich modern furnishings, curated art and artefacts, and the latest technology, which includes international direct dial telephones, safety boxes, and complimentary Wi-Fi and air-conditioning throughout.

The villa is set in the grounds of an ancient olive grove, and is surrounded by its own Mediterranean garden with stunning sea views. The large living area is furnished with a big blue sofa, and a matching chaise, which can be made into a sofa bed. For you home entertainment there is a multi-channel flat screen television, and Bluetooth connectivity. A fully equipped separate kitchen area has a table and four chairs to entertain your guests, with a minibar, and the latest Nespresso machine in which to make your morning coffee. The master bedroom is decorated with sea blue highlights, a king size bed, side tables, and wardrobe, and an en-suite bathroom. The marble bathroom is very impressive with a free-standing oval bath, a glass-fronted walk-in power shower, a double handbasin vanity unit, WC, hairdryer, luxury Angsana toiletries, and complimentary slippers, and bathrobes. For your convenience there is a separate guest cloakroom with a shower, WC and handbasin.

Step out of the floor to ceiling French doors from the sitting room or bedroom onto a decked terrace, where you will find your own private swimming pool with steps, and four comfortable sun loungers with shady parasols on which to relax. There is also has a paved area with a table and four chairs for alfresco dining with panoramic views, and a seating area where you can sip cocktails and watch the sun set over the Ionian Sea. For the beach bunnies there's a very handy complimentary Angsana beach bag set to take home with you too!

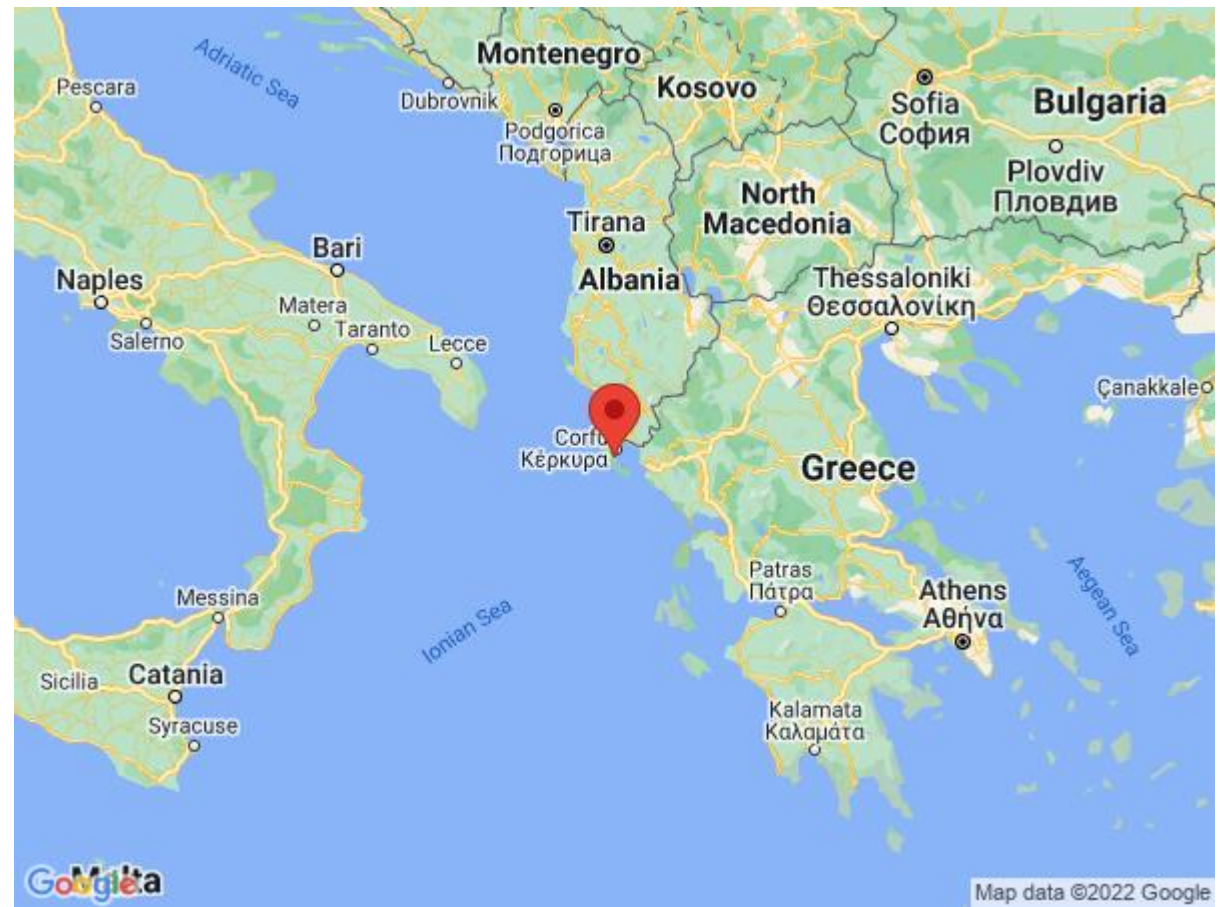


Location & Local Information

Angsana Sea View Villas are situated in the stunning Angsana Spa and Beach Resort of Akra Punta, overlooking the beautiful Benitses Bay, on the coast of island of Corfu, set in the heart of the Ionian Sea, part of the Greek Peloponnese. The resort is set atop verdant green hills with panoramic sea views over Benitses Bay, and just a short twelve kilometres to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Corfu town, and a twenty minute drive from the Ioannis Kapodistrias International Airport. Feel like a jet setter with an optional extra airport to Angsana Resort speedboat transfer. The resort is set in tendered Mediterranean gardens populated with olive trees, and is an idyllic spot to spend a relaxing holiday, whether the focus is on health and well-being or exploring the history and flora and fauna of this fascinating island.

Angsana Resort offers a fusion of Greek and Asian hospitality, from food and fine dining to feeding your spirit and soul in the spa. Choose to dine and imbibe at four fabulous restaurants, seven dedicated bars, and a sprinkling of outdoor lounge terraces with sea and countryside views. Start your culinary odyssey with the eponymously named "Bottrini's", the resort's signature restaurant, headed up by Ettore Bottrini, the Michelin-starred chef. Enjoy Asian fusion cooking at Koh, all day dining in Ruen Romsai, or sample the delights of Greek cuisine in the Sofrito Taverna. Get dizzy with sparkling cocktails at the Vertigo Bar, enjoy gourmet snacks in the V Lounge, have a taste of summer at the Emerald Beach Bar, swim up to the Sunrise Beach Bar, or sip a Sundowner in the Starboard Lounge. After all that eating and drinking, feed your spirit in the award-winning Angsana Spa, a sanctuary for the senses, with eleven treatment rooms, five outdoor pavilions, and a yoga terrace. The spa uses only natural ingredients from fruits and flowers in traditional aromatherapy treatments that combine Asian wellness techniques with Greek philoxenia, the philosophy of generosity of spirit and kindness. Cool down and have swim in the resort's outdoor infinity pool, or indoor spa pool, and keep fit in their state-of-the-art gym. For those who prefer swimming in the sea, there is a beach with its own Water Sports Centre.

Venture further afield with a trip to Benitses Bay, where you can take daily boat trips, cruise along the shore, or island hop to Paxoi and Antipaxoi, islets in the Ionian Sea. Corfu town is well worth a visit, steeped in thousands of years of history, Venetian architecture, French influences, and English rule, Follow the ancient winding streets to discover fortresses and palaces, Byzantine and Archeological museums, souvenir shops, and a whole host of inviting restaurants, cafes, and bars. Visit Achilleion Palace, once the summer home of Sisi, Elizabeth, Empress of Austria, or take a trip to Mon Repos Palace, the summer residence of the King of Greece, and birthplace of Prince Philip.
