Overview

Whether you're visiting the Biarritz coastline for the surfing vibe or hoping to explore the beautiful landscapes of the Pays Basque, La Cabane Du Surfeur offers contemporary living in relaxed surroundings just a short drive from the Atlantic shores of Bidart.

This modern home is all about stylish open-plan living, perfect for warm summer months when you can open the floor-to-ceiling sliding windows and step straight out to the covered terrace for long al-fresco lunches by the *plancha* and lounging by the heated swimming pool within the walled garden.

On the ground floor, three smart bedrooms each have their own shower rooms and doors leading out to a garden terrace whilst upstairs is the spacious master bedroom with an impressive bathroom. Across the four en suite bedrooms and living spaces there's an air of simple sophistication with great comfort as well as style.

Set in a neighbourhood just outside Bidart, it's around a 2km drive to the heart of the elevated seaside village, an absolutely charming place with beautiful Basque architecture, pretty cafes, shops and restaurant terraces. Admire the glorious ocean views from Chapelle Sainte-Madeleine then venture down the hill to the beach where you will find long stretches of sand and surf. You can also join the stunning coastal trail which leads all the way down to Hendaye and the Spanish border- this area is wonderful for walkers.

Bustling Biarritz is 5km to the north, family-friendly Saint-Jean-de-Luz is only a 20-minute drive south or you may prefer to hang out along the coast en route with so many gorgeous beaches from Plage d'Ilbarritz to the popular surfing spots around Guéthary.

Not forgetting the magnificent Basque interiors and views of the mighty Rhune mountain. For an authentic taste of Basque life, visit idyllic villages such as Ainhoa, La Bastide-Clairence and Sare, all classified as three of the most beautiful villages in France.

Location & Local Information

In the Pyrénées-Atlantiques, La Cabane Du Surfeur is 5km south of Biarritz, a short drive from the charming village of Bidart and the beautiful beaches of the Atlantic coastline.

Positioned in a neighbourhood in the outskirts of Bidart, it's around a 500m walk up to the main road leading to Biarritz where you will find a range of amenities including large supermarkets and, a little further, a small handful of places to eat.

The elevated Basque village of Bidart is only 2km away – it's such a delightful place with traditional houses, pretty shops as well as restaurant and café terraces. Wander across to Chapelle Sainte-Madeleine for wonderful ocean views or venture down to one of the beaches below (some accessed via rocky paths and steps). This part of the coastline is much loved by surfers with Plage d'Ilbarritz to the north and the beaches of Guéthary to the south, but they are also adored by families looking for sandy bays and stunning scenery.

The coastal trail heading all the way down to Hendaye and the Spanish border starts in Bidart and this region is also popular with cyclists with routes near the coastline as well as through the Basque interiors. Other popular activities across this area include horse-riding, fishing, tree-top adventure courses and golf in one of the many courses near Biarritz and Saint-Jean-de-Luz.


Spend time in the elegant seaside town of Biarritz where 19th century aristocrats once built their summer residences along the beach, including Hotel du Palais by the iconic Grande Plage. Dine out in Port des Pecheurs or buy fresh fish and other regional delicacies at the bustling Halles de Biarritz indoor market. The Rocher de la Vierge is certainly a highlight of the town, a peninsular connected via the Eiffel bridge, or head north to admire the ocean views from the lighthouse.

Driving south, past the popular surfing village of Guéthary, Saint-Jean-de-Luz benefits from a lovely sandy beach, watersports and a generally family-friendly vibe whilst Ciboure is full of charm, especially by its characterful harbour.

Yet it's not all about the spectacular landscapes of the Atlantic coast. Traditional villages that showcase Basque's beautiful interiors can be easily reached such as Ainhoa and Sare, both under half an hour by car and classified as two of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'.
