

Villa Caria

Overview

It's all about the view when you stay at Villa Caria, situated just outside of the town of Kas, overlooking the dramatic coastline of the stunning Mediterranean Turquoise Coast, Turkey. This ultra-modern three bedroom, three bathroom villa can comfortably sleep up to six guests. This two storey detached villa is the latest in contemporary design with stark whitewashed walls, full length glass windows, and metal surrounds, nestled in the hillside with sea views from every room. The villa is decorated in a neutral palette with cool accent colours, including gun metal grey and iron blues on the ground floor, and bright jewel highlights in the bedrooms. It's the perfect holiday home for a family or friends' sharing, and enjoying time in the Turkish sunshine.

Enter the villa at ground floor level to reveal an open plan living space. The adjacent dining area has a modern dark grey table and six metal chairs, great for some indoor entertaining. There is a small, practical L-shaped white kitchen, equipped with everything you will need for your stay, including a family-sized fridge-freezer and a traditional Turkish coffee maker. On the ground floor there is a large bedroom with two twin beds, and floor to ceiling windows that give access to the pool terrace and superb sea views. Take the stairs to the first floor where you will find two spacious double bedrooms. The first has a sapphire blue velvet in-set surround bed, wardrobes, dressing table and mirror, an in-room Jacuzzi bath, an en-suite marble shower room, and floor to ceiling windows that offer spectacular sea views, and open to a balcony, where you can enjoy a morning coffee and watch the sunrise. The second bedroom has a large ruby red round in-set bed, in-room Jacuzzi bath with a view, an en-suite marble shower room, and a balcony with beautiful sea views, where you can sit sipping cocktails as the sun sets.

Access the pool terrace from the ground floor living area, where there is an impressive swimming pool, perfect for a few lengths before breakfast. The pool is surrounded by six mesh sun loungers, shady parasols, and a swing chair in which to while the day away. Relax on the cushioned soft seating area, or catch up on some holiday reading on the matching bench. Shop for local homegrown produce in the weekly market, and eat alfresco in the pergola dining area with table and six chairs.




Location & Local Information

Villa Caria is in the most stunning location, built into the foothills of the Taurus mountains, above the coast road between the towns of Kalkan and Kas, with panoramic sea views of the aptly named Turquoise Coast, the jewel of the Mediterranean Sea. The villa is 155 kilometres from Dalaman International Airport, a scenic mountain and coast road journey that takes approximately two hours by car.

The nearest town is quaint Kas is just over three kilometres away, with its Ottoman houses hanging with pastel coloured bougainvillea, winding streets, busy working harbour, and lots of inviting restaurants, cafes and bars, as well as a lively music scene in the evening. The town draws an international crowd, and has some seriously good shopping, whether its for hand crafted souvenirs, fabulous holiday fashion, delicious foods from organic grocers and delis, and the must-see Friday market. The nearest beach from the villa is just three kilometres away, on the way into Kas there is an impressive marina, which is home to luxury yachts cruising the Med. Around the Kas coastline there are lots of exclusive beach clubs, where you can enjoy a day sunbathing on wooden platforms, diving into the sea from jetties, swimming and snorkelling, and sampling the local fare in their cafes and restaurants.

No stay in Kas is complete with a boat trip from the harbour, all aboard for a day at sea, snorkelling and swimming, discovery secret coves and beautiful bays, not to mention the homemade mixed meze lunch and fresh fish served for lunch. If you want to go further afield ask the captain to take you to Kekova, where you can view a sunken city through a glass bottomed boat, climb ancient Roman ruins, and try the famous homemade ice cream as an afternoon treat. For those interested in history Kas is fully of surprises, just a walk around town will uncover amphitheatres, tombs, and archaeological sites from Lycian, Greek, Byzantine and Roman times. A boat trip to Aperlai allows you to swim above age old ruins, and get off the boat to wander through Roman remains. The coast road to Kalkan is well worth a trip, with breath taking views of the stunning and dramatic coastline that dates back to the time of Homer. On the way stop at Kaputas beach, formed from a natural gorge, there's only two hundred steps down to a beautiful beach with sunbeds and parasols, cafes and loos, and the most welcoming warm sea in which to swim. If nature is your thing the area around Kas has it all, follow the famous Lycian Way, trek the trail to discover the areas natural flora and fauna. And if you've really got itchy feet and a desire to travel, you can always get to Greece from Kas harbour by taking the daily twenty minute ferry to Meis.
