Location & Local Information

Villa Eugenio enjoys a quiet and peaceful location high above the historic village of Santa Cruz - one of the oldest villages on the island of Madeira. Here you will find many beautiful rocky and black sandy beaches to enjoy, including the Praia das Palmeiras, which offers fantastic sunset views and is a great place to spend a relaxing day, with its seafront promenade lined with palm trees and restaurants.

For somewhere a little more 'touristy', nearby Funchal is well worth a visit especially for those who enjoy watersports and other outdoor activities. Funchal is the island's capital and is one of the most popular areas with visitors to Madeira, thanks to its mild year-round temperatures, stunning landscapes, and variety of things to see and do. Whatever outdoor pursuits you are into, you're sure to find them here in Funchal, whether it's hiking or cycling, swimming, scuba diving, snorkelling, paragliding, surfing or even golf. Boat trips are popular here, as are whale-watching tours - and you'll find plenty of places in the region offering such excursions, so Oliver highly recommends booking up if you want the chance to do something really unique during your stay.

If it's nightlife you're after, you won't be disappointed either, as Funchal comes alive after dark while still retaining the calm and laid-back atmosphere that tourists love. Guests who come here like to spend the evenings and earlier parts of the night dining in one of the many restaurants and bars - perhaps sampling some Poncha, a delicious local sugar cane rum! - and then heading home for a few hours before setting out again around midnight, with bars and clubs in the area offering good music and a friendly ambience right through until 7 am!

Funchal is a fantastic place to visit all year round, with lots of exciting attractions and festivals to experience. The city's Carnival and Flower Festival is celebrated during the summer months, where you can enjoy samba beats and colourful costumed parades, as well as June's Atlantic Festival's International Fireworks Competition and the region's famous wine festival. One of Funchal's best-known celebrations is its New Year's Eve firework display, which is one of the largest in the world, and if you happen to be visiting Funchal during the Christmas period, you'll be treated to a twinkling wonderland as the whole city comes alive with lights.
