

Casa Coru

Region: Galicia Sleeps: 10

Overview

Located near the small town of Bertamirans, close to Santiago de Compostela, sits this tranquil four-bedroom villa. Surrounded by countryside, the location is wonderfully quiet and is the perfect destination for a family wanting relaxation, outdoor activities and nearby historical attractions.

Inside, the decor is modern and light. On the ground floor, exposed stonewalls, creamy tones and tiled flooring sweep through the living area, creating a soothing atmosphere. Two large sofas invite you to sit and chat with friends and family or relax with a film on the flatscreen television. On chilly days, cosy up next to the roaring fire, but when the sun's shining, you'll want to push open the floor-to-ceiling glass doors and let the outside in. There's also a hardwood dining table that invites sociability. Off from the living area is a spacious kitchen with all the appliances you'll need to cook up delicious family meals and a neat table, perfectly set up for a more casual bite to eat. Also on this floor is a light and airy double bedroom with an adapted bathroom for guests with reduced mobility. From the ground floor, stairs lead up to the first floor, where the three remaining bedrooms are located. Featuring a mix of double and twin beds, the rooms are all a generous size with windows that overlook rolling hills and treetops. There are also two immaculate bathrooms on this floor.

Back on the ground floor, step outside onto the terrace and start the day with a morning coffee while listening to birdsong in the surrounding trees. During the day, take it easy on a sun lounger, swim in the pool, or relax in the pretty garden with a good book. After a day of relaxation, light the stone barbeque and gather everyone together for an alfresco meal at the table under the vines of the shaded terrace.

The house is set in a peaceful location, backed by woodland and surrounded by trees. It's ideally located for outdoor activity with hiking and cycling routes right on the doorstep, while there are amenities nearby, with the small town of Bertamirans just a ten-minute drive away. The historical and cultural city of Santiago de Compostela is also a 25-minute drive away, with plenty to do there.

Location & Local Information

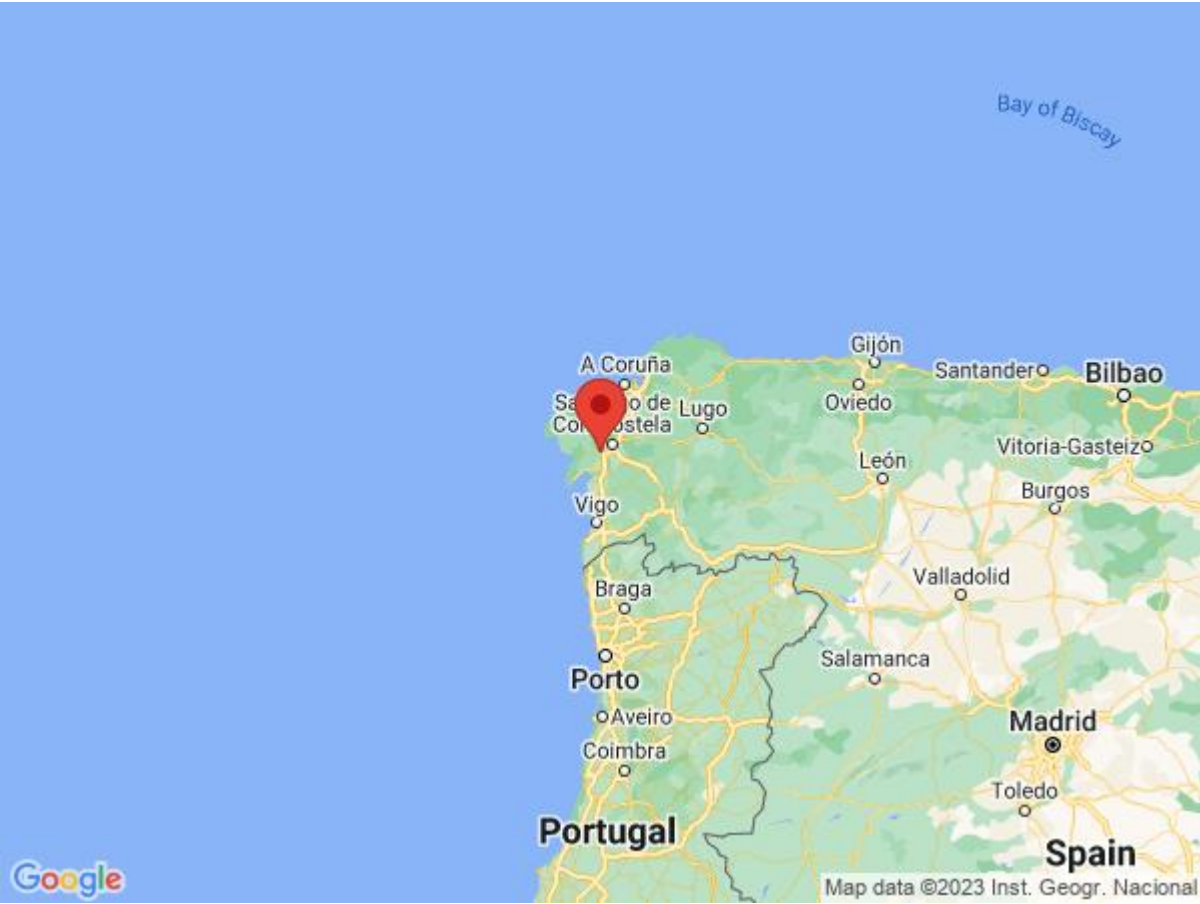
Surrounded by trees, Casa Coru is located inland and overlooks a valley. You can explore the stunning landscape on foot or bicycle, and nature lovers will enjoy spotting wildlife in the oak, birch and chestnut trees.

Galicia is known for its gastronomy, and there are a number of restaurants in the town of Bertamirnas where you can sample local seafood dishes and a glass of crisp white Albarino wine. But for a full day of history and culture, make the 25-minute drive to the beautiful Santiago de Compostela (Galicia's capital). This ancient pilgrimage centre is packed with Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Neoclassicist buildings and its twisting stone lanes make it a pleasant city to explore on foot. Admire the grandeur of the stunning Catedral de Santiago de Compostela and the remarkable Portico de la Gloria, and be sure to take a tour of the roof of the Cathedral too. A whole day can easily be spent exploring Santiago's most famous building and the squares surrounding the Cathedral, but if you need a breather, head to the leafy Alameda Park close to the old quarter. At the park entrance, be sure to stop and admire the sculpture of *As Marias*. The sculpture features two sisters whose family was prosecuted during the Franco regime. The sisters became known for strolling through the park dressed in eye-catching, colourful outfits at the same time every day.

After a stroll in urban nature, head to Rua do Franco and enjoy a drink and tapas at one of the many bars dotted along this road. Alternatively, head to the Mercado de Abastos, a charming stone building housing a lively and bustling market. This daily market is packed with seafood and vegetables plus local specialities, including *questo de tetilla* cheese and *tarta de Santiago* almond cake. But for something a little more contemporary, head to the north side of town and discover the Centro Galego de Arte Contemporanea. This elegant, modern building sits in striking contrast to Santiago's ancient buildings, and inside, the exhibition halls are swathed in natural light from massive windows and skylights. It's a lovely space and home to permanent and changing exhibitions of contemporary art and sculpture.
