Overview

If you are looking for a place to stay with your family or a group of friends which offers comfort and a fantastic French Riviera location, then look no further than Voltaire.

Voltaire is a gorgeous villa which has just recently been completed and has everything you could need in a holiday home. The house is spread over two floors including four bedrooms to accommodate guests, with air-conditioning, Wi-Fi and flatscreen TVs available throughout the home.

The ground floor is where you will find three of the bedrooms; all of these rooms are bright and spacious with a monochrome colour palette, crisp clean linen and en-suite bathrooms. Upstairs there is another bedroom which is the master suite. This room is expansive and has access to the large terrace where you can welcome the day as you sip your morning coffee. On top of this, the suite has a king-sized bed, a dressing room, a chic en-suite bathroom and also an office area in case you need to work whilst away.

Outdoors, the home is enveloped by a lush, leafy garden which is gated. The garden is a peaceful retreat which looks out over Port Grimaud and the dazzling sea. As the climate here is wonderful, you will want to make the most of the outside space - dining al-fresco, reading a book on the sun loungers and taking a dip in the heated infinity pool.

This attractive home is managed by an exclusive 5* hotel which is 500m away, meaning the staff have a wealth of experience in hosting and meeting the needs of guests. Your holiday starts when you are greeted with a champagne reception and if you would like to book additional extras such as a driver, a stocked fridge or a babysitter these can be arranged for you. Guests staying at Voltaire also have access to the serene spa at the hotel where you can indulge in massages and beauty treatments, work out at the gym and book a session with the personal trainers and also partake in the buffet breakfast.

The main attraction of this area is of course the glamorous port town of Saint-Tropez which is only 4.5km away. Saint-Tropez has a wide range of cafes and restaurants, from small family run bistros to some of the finest eateries in all of France. Celebrities and socialites also flock here for the designer shopping as the town is filled with incredible boutique stores.

In the heart of Saint-Tropez there is also an atmospheric old town, topped by a medieval fortress known as the citadel. Visitors can explore the pretty, narrow



streets filled with artisan shops, historic chapels and a number of great museums and galleries including a modern art gallery, film museum and a police museum. A lovely way to finish the day is to gather together a harbour-side bar for a glass of wine with staggering views.

When you would like to visit a beach, you will have lots to choose from; whether you would like to sip a cocktail at a luxury beach club at Pampelonne Beach, 8km by car, or you would prefer a natural cove surrounded by hiking trails such as Gigaro beach.

There are plenty of places nearby that you can visit for day trips outside of Saint-Tropez including taking a boat trip out to the enchanting Golden Islands or driving over to the sister town of Sainte-Maxime which is 13km away.

Location & Local Information

Voltaire is the perfect place to stay for a holiday on the French Riviera. With sleepy historic villages, long sandy beaches and the centre of Saint-Tropez town all within easy reach, there is plenty to see and do without having to travel very far.

If you wish to go out for dinner just a short walk away, why not head over to the nearby 5* hotel, the sister property of the villa, 500m away. At the hotel you can tuck in to a delicious meal at the gourmet restaurant which offers European-Asian fusion food and as they can cater for everyone including vegan diets this is a great option for groups. As well as evening meals, guests staying at the villa can also enjoy breakfast at the hotel and access their world-class facilities such as the gym and spa.

When you would like to head in to Saint-Tropez town, you are just 4.5km away! Within a few minutes you can be sitting on a sandy beach sipping a cocktail, gazing out over the stunning blue sea.

There are a wide range of beaches in this area; you can find small swimming coves, famous beaches with exclusive beach clubs such as Plage de Pampelonne (8km) and also beaches that offer water sports such as Plage de la Moutte.

Aside from unwinding on the beach, Saint-Tropez has lots of things you can do. If you are a history lover then wander around the hilltop medieval citadel which once defended the town and now houses a maritime museum and is located within the picture-postcard old town. The old town is a lovely place to pass an afternoon looking at the ancient churches, watching the fishing boats on the port and visiting some of the brilliant museums such as the fine art gallery and the butterfly museum. If you would like to do a bit of shopping then you are definitely in the right place! In Saint-Tropez you can find everything from bustling markets which are held throughout the week and designer boutiques.

If you would like to explore a different part of the Riviera then why not drive over to Grimaud which is 10km away. This is a large village which has a wide selection of eateries and shops. Grimaud has a rich history and hails from the early medieval era which you will see in the gorgeous architecture. One place to look around is the incredible castle ruins where you can learn about how the castle was destroyed during the French Revolution. If you are here during summer then you could get tickets for one of the amazing open-air concerts held in the castle grounds.

A few kilometres away you can also visit Port-Grimaud which has a completely different character from the historic part. Port-Grimaud is beautiful and is quite new. The town has been built up around existing waterways much like Venice



in Italy. You can explore the town by boat which will weave in and out of the rows of pastel-hued shops and restaurants, dropping you off wherever you wish.
