A morning dip in the villa's large private pool is the perfect way to begin your day, with birdsong and the blue skies of Istria above you. There are sun loungers available should you wish to spend the day relaxing by the pool with a book, taking in the lush greens of the garden around you. The secluded garden benefits from shady trees, shrubbery, and the scent of lavender as the sun goes down in the evening. There is a play area for young children and a beautiful outside dining area covered by a pergola with a leafy canopy, the ideal spot for a memorable meal at home.

Entering the villa through the patio door, you will find yourself in an ample, open-plan living space featuring gorgeous tile flooring, rustic timber ceilings and exposed brickwork. The comfortable seating area and feature fireplace make this a true haven for a cosy night in with a glass of local wine beside a crackling fire. This space also features an elegant dining area overlooked by a light-filled window and a characterful stone archway leading into the traditional and well-appointed kitchen.

Upstairs, the villa continues to delight with its relaxed warmth and authentic finishes. High vaulted ceilings, bright white walls and the expansive views of the countryside and the sea on the horizon give both bedrooms an air of peace and tranquillity. The master bedroom features simple furnishings such as a wooden double bed, an ample wardrobe, a traditional dresser and a cane chair. The villa's second bedroom has a double bed and a single bed, alongside another large wardrobe. Dual-aspect windows offer stunning natural light. The lovely bathroom, where you will find a walk-in shower and two separate washbasins, also benefits from the beautiful view.



Local Istrians are fiercely proud of the region's diverse landscapes, encompassing rolling vineyards, olive groves and peaceful green meadows. Hiking enthusiasts will be amazed by the nearby trails, which pass through unspoiled rural villages with stone houses and incredible coastline views. Near the villa, guests will find local olive oil producers and winemakers showcasing the very best of the region's rich gastronomy. A short drive away, restaurants, local shops and a convenient supermarket are nearby.

For those needing a complete reset, visit the nearby town of Portorož. Known for its therapeutic spas and exquisite sandy beaches, you can enjoy the soothing effects of both thermal and seawater. You may also wish to treat yourself to a luxurious massage! Experts are on hand to guide you through your day of pampering at the Shakti-Ayurveda or the Lifeclass Terme Portorož Spa.

Even closer is the picturesque town of Izola, where you can stroll along the marina and wander the old, cobbled alleyways before a leisurely lunch at one of the town's excellent restaurants. Izola is best known for its ancient ties to the tradition of fishing, but the nearby countryside also offers visitors the opportunity to visit local farms devoted to olive and fruit growing. The town of Strunjan, famous for its fantastic variety of flora and fauna, is a short tenminute drive away.

On the Slovenian coast, the Se?ovlje Salina Nature Park is a cultural gem that introduces visitors to the tradition of salt production within a unique saline landscape. Visit the spa in the northern part of the park, where quests enjoy restorative salt and mud baths, known for boosting circulation and naturally improving the skin.

The old port town of Piran, often called Slovenia's most beautiful coastal town, is said to have flourished with the help of a bit of salt. The town has a distinctly









Mediterranean feel and is much admired for its impressive architecture, breathtaking views and culinary delights. Piran's Cape Madonna is home to incredible underwater biodiversity at the tip of the peninsula. This is the perfect place to indulge in a day of water sports on the Adriatic coastline before returning to your tranquil villa for dinner with a view.
