

Trullo Fasolara

Overview

Nestled in the picturesque countryside, this idyllic trullo is surrounded by lush olive groves and cherry orchards, offering the perfect getaway for those looking to escape the hustle and bustle of everyday life. Whether you're looking to explore the charming towns and villages of Puglia or relax by the pool, Trullo Fasolara has everything you need to make the most of the Italian sunshine.

This authentic trullo has been delicately restored to maintain its original character. The arched living room is built from pale stone from the local area, complete with an open fireplace and comfortable sofas – perfect for getting cosy in the evenings. The dining room sits beneath the villa's main dome, decorated with Italian ceramics atop artisanal wooden furniture.

The use of natural materials, from wooden beams to stone floors, adds to the rustic charm and creates a feeling of warmth and comfort. High ceilings and large windows flood the space with natural light, highlighting intricate details and craftsmanship of the architecture.

Trullo Fasolara boasts a stunning outdoor area perfect for entertaining or relaxing in the sun. The glistening pool is the centrepiece of the garden, surrounded by greenery and comfortable seating. The pizza oven and outdoor kitchen are perfect for summer barbecues and making delicious meals to enjoy al fresco.

The nearby town of Alberobello, with its charming rows of traditional trullo houses made of local limestone and cone-roofed structures, mirrors the architectural style of the villa. The town also has a Church and museum, providing a glimpse into its rich history and culture.

A mere 10km away is the charming town of Noci, where you can savour delicious Apulian cuisine, including orecchiette pasta and panzerotti, at one of the traditional restaurants. The town's historic centre boasts a variety of well-preserved medieval and baroque buildings, including an imposing castle. Take a leisurely stroll through the charming streets and admire the architecture, such as the 14th-century church of Santa Maria degli Angeli.



35km away lies the town of Polignano a Mare, home to the splendid Lama Monachile beach, where you can immerse yourself in the Mediterranean's natural splendour. Unwind on the white sandy beach or snorkel in the crystal-clear waters and spot the marine life.

Located just 55km away is the vibrant city of Bari, the capital of Puglia. The old town, Bari Vecchia, is a must-see destination with its narrow winding streets, charming alleys and historic buildings. Make sure you visit the Basilica of Saint Nicholas, with its impressive mosaics and intricate carvings. History buffs will love the Bari National Archaeological Museum, which houses a collection of items from the Roman, Greek and Byzantine periods.

Location & Local Information

Situated in beautiful rural surroundings, there are plenty of nearby routes to hike, which will take you through landscapes made up of olive groves and cherry orchards. Alberobello nearby boasts a similar architectural style as the villa, featuring rows of traditional trullo houses with unique cone-roofed structures made of local limestone. Stop by one of the restaurants, try one of the traditional Pugliese dishes, and sample some Italian wines. The town also features a church and museum, offering a glimpse into the town's history and culture.

Drive around 10km to Noci, a quaint town home to several eateries where you can try delicious Apulian cuisine such as orecchiette pasta and panzerotti. Its beautiful historic centre features a number of well-preserved medieval and baroque buildings, as well as an impressive castle. Take a stroll through its charming streets and admire the architecture, including the Santa Maria degli Angeli church, which dates back to the 14th century.

Experience the natural beauty of the Mediterranean Sea by visiting Lama Monachile beach, situated in the town of Polignano a Mare, 35km away. Sunbathe on the sandy shoreline or snorkel in its crystal clear waters. The shore is also home to the annual World Cliff Diving Championship, where divers from all over the world compete.

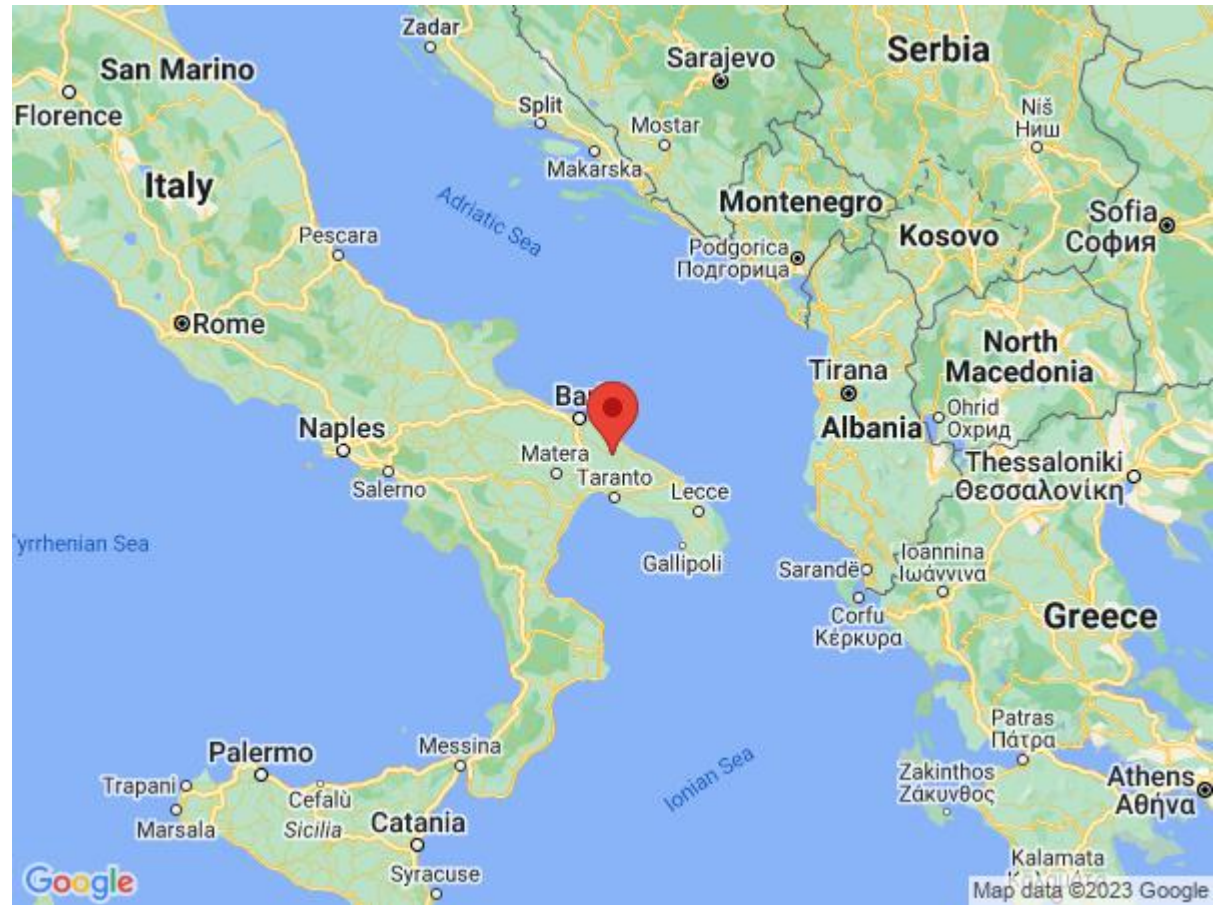
