### **Location & Local Information**

With a coastline encompassing serene bays, lush green headlands, coral reefs and blue lagoons, the island of Antigua offers families and couples alike the chance to explore the wonders of the ocean whilst soaking up the Caribbean sunshine! The nation of Antigua and Barbuda is made up of two sister islands and several smaller islets, all situated where the Caribbean Sea meets the Atlantic Ocean. At just 281 km², Antigua holds the title of the nation's largest island. However, it remains a tiny, untouched corner of paradise - the perfect size for a relaxed Caribbean getaway.

The island's 365 beaches, one for every day of the year, are a source of great pride for local Antiguans. The fantastic location of Tamarind Hills on the island's south-west coastline means you will have the fine white sands of two idyllic beaches, Ffryes and Darkwood, right on your doorstep. Surrounded by luscious green hilltops, Ffryes Beach is a popular spot with tourists and locals alike. You can spend the morning snorkeling in the turquoise waters here, before indulging in a long lunch at one of the local restaurants around Jolly Harbour. Darkwood Beach is known for being one of the most picturesque places on the entire island, so bring your camera for a leisurely stroll at sunset.

A trip to Nelson's Dockyard National Park makes for an exciting day out. This UNESCO World Heritage site features an eighteenth-century British naval dockyard at its centre. As well as being a site of great historical significance, this is also a popular venue for the island's maritime events. Every year, Antigua Sailing Week attracts hundreds of yachts and thousands of spectators to the dockyard. For those who wish to experience the magic for themselves, there are plenty of sailing excursions and water-based activities available.

The island also offers visitors some fantastic trekking trails, taking in sandy beaches, lush forests and dreamlike coastal views. For a challenging hike, wear comfortable walking gear and visit Mount Obama, the highest peak in Antigua. From the summit, enjoy the panoramic views, before descending to Cades Bay for a delightfully refreshing dip in the ocean.

St. John's is the Antiguan capital, a small and colourful Caribbean port city that is easily accessed within twenty minutes by car. Here you will find the white twin towers of St. John's Cathedral, as well as the Museum of Antigua and Barbuda, providing a fascinating look at the island's heritage and history. Visit the harbour at St. John's over the weekend and chances are you will find yourself wandering through a lively local market.

Another popular destination is Shirley Heights, a restored military lookout known for its bewitching sunsets. Shirley Heights is famous for its community feel, with a popular street party happening every Sunday afternoon. Here,
