Manoir Cotentin

Region: Normandy Sleeps: 8

Overview

Manoir Cotentin allows you the opportunity to stay in a prestigious 17th century home in the Normandy countryside near the sea, close to wonderful beaches, World War II memorial sites and authentic restaurants serving *moules* straight from the English channel.

This 4-bedroom historic residence sleeps up to 8 guests in picturesque surroundings. Dating back to the time of Louis XIII, appreciate the manoir's exquisite architecture and refined furnishings across its graceful rooms. Woodbeamed ceilings, luxurious curtains and an abundance of natural light add to the historic elegance of the living room, the kitchen is simply gorgeous (you can even catch a glimpse of the sea from the window) whilst the formal dining room is stunning with its classic décor and artwork. Each of the four pretty bedrooms has its own bathroom – the roll top bath in one of the doubles is especially romantic.

Imagine enjoying breakfast outside on summer mornings as the birds sing. The beautiful garden and grounds are shared with two other detached historic residences, a unique *pigeonnier* and a *pavillon* which are rented out separately (please enquire for pricing and availability). The estate is just perfect for an evening stroll or moments of quiet reflection by the lawns, summer roses and stone walls.

Grab a bike and cycle to the sea, only 3.5km away, dine out in a traditional Normandy restaurant serving fresh seafood or head straight to the sandy shore. At low tide, look for oysters and other shellfish whilst there's horseriding along the beach in July and August for experienced riders (and a ponyclub near the estate for beginners). Drive 10km south to Utah Beach for sandyachting and visit the fascinating WWII Utah Beach Landing Museum.

Further north, admire the granite houses of Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue, walk along the peninsula to the Vauban Tower (a UNESCO World Heritage site) and catch the boat with wheels across to Tatihou Island with its museum, beaches and botanical gardens (you could even walk there at low tide). Barfleur also awaits for *moules-frites* in one of its inviting harbourside restaurants.

Closer to home, the village of Sainte-Mère-Église, one of the first to be liberated by the Allied forces, awaits with its delicious biscuit shop and weekly market showcasing the best regional specialities, not only oysters and other









sea-food but also calvados, cider, Isigny butter, cream and delicious cheeses – this part of Normandy is gastronomes' paradise!

Location & Local Information

On Normandy's Cotentin peninsula, 48km from Cherbourg ferry terminal, Manoir Cotentin is set within beautiful gardens only 3.5km from the coast.

The tiny nearby village has a small shop and French restaurant whilst there is another restaurant, specialising in fresh Normandy sea-food, by the sea. Listen out as the village's pretty church, next to the estate, rings its bells at 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m (and every half hour inbetween for a shorter period).

Make the most of the bikes provided and cycle down the country lanes to the sea, passing farmland and marshes until you reach long stretches of sandy shore, backed by the coastal road that connects Utah Beach to Quinéville and its World War Two museum. There are several memorials and WWII sites scattered close by whilst the fascinating Utah Beach Landing Museum is only 10km by car.


Only 3.5km away, the nearby beach is wonderful for long walks, admiring the coloured houses lining the beach and a fort that played an important role in WWII. During low tide, look out for oyster beds along this part of the coast and when it's time for high tide, the sea is fantastic for swimming. Horse-riding can be found here in the height of the summer, there is sand yachting further south whilst to the north, within a 10-minute drive, an 18-hole golf course is a beautiful place to tee off.

Drive north to Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue (20km) with its picturesque marina, old houses and excellent fish restaurants by the port. Keen walkers can head towards the Vauban Tower, a UNESCO World Heritage site, for incredible views or venture towards Tatihou Island with its maritime museum and botanical gardens, reached via a boat with wheels or on foot across the oyster beds in low tide. Barfleur (27km) is also full of charm with its granite houses and delicious mussels harvested from the English channel – when in season, a lunch of moules-frites is a must!

Heading inland, the local village of Sainte-Mère-Église (6.5km), one of the first villages to be liberated by the Allied forces in WWII, hosts a Thursday morning market and don't miss a trip to Biscuiterie de Sainte-Mère-Église for its delicious Normandy biscuits and sweet treats. The town of Valognes (18km) is home to several 17th and 18th century mansions and has a bustling market on a Friday morning.

Of course, Le Parc des Marais and its coastline offers a wealth of opportunities for walking, cycling, fishing and even river boat trips from the port in Les Ponts d'Ouve.

Further afield, spend the day admiring the maritime city of Cherbourg (48km),









soaking up the charm of Barneville-Carteret (44km), visiting the historic town and tapestry of Bayeux (62km), spending time by other D-Day landing beaches around Arromanches-les-Bains (71km) or experiencing the Belle Époque ambience of Deauville (136km), reached in under two hours by car.
