The stunning Pelican House is a palatial property encompassing two neighbouring three-bedroom villas and a private swimming pool. With spectacular views over the turquoise waters of Soldier's Bay, the villas boast private beach access via a flight of steps, with silky white sands right on your doorstep.

Blue skies and the warm island breeze will draw you down to the idyllic terrace each morning, where you can spend the day sunbathing by the swimming pool, dipping in and out of the cooling water as you please. The dreamlike views of the Caribbean Sea framed by gently swaying palm trees instill a true sense of tranquility, providing the perfect backdrop for an afternoon spent unwinding on a sun lounger with a good book or an evening spent sipping coconut cocktails. Each of the villas also features a verandah with comfortable outdoor seating, where guests can enjoy a leisurely breakfast of fresh fruits or a romantic sunset dinner. From the terrace, you can always stroll down to the secluded beach below, for an invigorating swim in the ocean.

The serene ambience continues within each of the Pelican House villas, with an elegant open-plan living space benefitting from an abundance of natural light thanks to wide patio doors and tall windows. Each expansive living space comprises a relaxing lounge area with sumptuous sofas and a flat screen TV, the ideal place for you to rest after a day spent exploring the wonders of Antigua. The lounge area flows seamlessly into the villa's traditional dining area, located a few steps away. Here, everyone can gather to discuss the day's adventures and enjoy a delicious meal prepared in the villa's well-equipped kitchen, featuring a breakfast bar and modern appliances.

Pelican House has been designed with laidback Caribbean living in mind, with effortless contemporary furnishings and understated décor echoing the natural colours and textures of the island. Each villa features an ample master bedroom on the first floor, with a four-poster bed, a private lounge area and a private balcony affording dazzling sea views. Another double bedroom with a balcony is also located on the first floor, while the villa's third double bedroom is on the ground floor, boasting direct access to the terrace. Each bedroom



features a modern en-suite bathroom with a walk-in shower and a luxurious bathtub. Fitted ceiling fans ensure that your nights are as restful as your days are relaxing.

After a dip in your own private swimming pool, you may wish to wander towards one of the resort's quiet beach coves, taking in fabulous green gardens along the way.

If you fancy venturing further afield, the stunning landscapes of Antigua lie waiting to be discovered! The nation of Antigua and Barbuda encompasses two namesake sister islands and several smaller islets. Local Antiguan are understandably proud of the island's 365 beaches, one for each day of the year. Here, you will be spoiled for choice when it comes to your next dip in the Caribbean Sea!

Tranquil beaches are only the beginning of all that this vibrant, friendly island has to offer. Only a fifteen-minute drive away, the Antiguan capital of St. John's is easily accessible. In this colourful port town, you will find the white twin towers of St. John's Cathedral, as well as the Museum of Antigua and Barbuda, providing a fascinating look at the island's heritage and history. Visit the harbour at St. John's over the weekend and chances are you will find yourself wandering through a lively local market.

Slightly further afield, Nelson's Dockyard National Park can be reached within forty-five minutes by car. One of five national parks in Antigua, this cultural treasure is located on the island's southern coastline. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, the eighteenth-century British naval dockyard is an area of great historical significance on the island, as well as a popular venue for maritime events and activities. For those who wish to experience the magic for themselves, there are plenty of sailing excursions and water-based activities available.

While taking in the sights at Nelson's Dockyard, don't forget to visit Shirley Heights, a restored military lookout known for its bewitching views and community feel. With a popular street party happening every Sunday evening, visitors are welcome to enjoy the music of live Caribbean steel drum bands, taste some of the local food and rum punch and take in the breathtaking sights as the sun begins to go down on the beautiful island of Antigua.

Antigua boasts a variety of fantastic trekking trails, situated around the island



and taking in sandy beaches, lush rainforests, and dreamlike coastal views. For a challenging day out, put on your hiking shoes and visit Mount Obama, the highest peak in Antigua. From the summit, enjoy the panoramic vistas of the island, before descending to Cades Bay for a delightfully refreshing dip in the ocean.
