Overview

For those seeking security and seclusion, then a holiday in the sea view Villa Serpil, is the vacation for you. Nestled in the hills above the exclusive holiday destination of Kalkan, on Turkey's Turquoise Coast, Villa Serpil is part of a small complex of luxury villas, resembling a tiny traditional Turkish village. Villa Serpil is an impressive two-storey detached property surrounded by a stone wall enclosing a small lawned garden and your private swimming pool. The complex has twenty-four seven security and an alarm system for your peace of mind. The villa has an allocated three car parking space, and use of the complex's super long swimming and children's pools, and relaxing sun loungers with parasols is part of the package. There is a family-friendly stylish clubhouse, serving food from breakfast until supper, and a swish cocktail bar and lounge for your enjoyment too. This charming three bedroom villa can comfortably accommodate up to six guests, ideal for a family or friends' get together.

The exterior of the villa is classic whitewashed walls, adorned with wooden shuttered windows, and a Mediterranean Sea view Juliet balcony. The interior is warm and welcoming, furnished with modern pieces, contrasting traditional Turkish lighting and artefacts, and decorated in muted earth tones, with highlights of sparkling bright orange.

Approach the architect designed complex down a purpose built road lined with shady tall trees, where you will find Villa Serpil on a stone path, surrounded by local lush shrubs, seasonal plants in terracotta pots, and colourful blossoming bougainvillea. The ground floor of the villa has a light and airy open plan living space, with French doors that lead out to the private garden and pool. The seating area has two huge comfy sofas, a matching pouffe, and a smart HD television. The adjacent dining set has an elegant wood table, and six upholstered chairs, ideal for some impressive indoor entertaining. The fully equipped kitchen is fitted with all the latest appliances to cater for your holiday, including a family size fridge freezer, a built in oven and hob, dishwasher and microwave, and that must-have morning juicer. A guest cloakroom completes the ground floor.

Take the stairs to the first floor, where you will find three well-appointed double bedrooms, The master bedroom has a double bed, a wardrobe, side tables, an en-suite bathroom with a walk-in shower, and a sea view balcony. The second









bedroom has a double bed, the third two twin beds, and there is a shared bathroom with walk-in shower, vanity unit, and WC. The walled lawned garden is a delight, with a step entry swimming pool surrounded by rattan style orange cushioned sun loungers with matching shady parasols, and a cooling down outside shower. Dine alfresco under the pergola, home to a smart rattan dining set with six orange cushioned chairs, and raise a glass of raki to a happy holiday.

Location & Local Information

Villa Serpil can be found nestled in the hills two kilometres above the quaint harbour town of Kalkan, situated on Turkey's Turquoise Coast, the jewel of the Mediterranean Sea. Kalkan was originally a Greek enclave called Kalamaki, and Ottoman and Hellenic influences can be found in the winding streets of the old harbour town. Walk through the cobbled streets full of traditional white houses, home to a reputed one hundred and fifty restaurants, cafes, bars, enticing souvenir shops, and designer brand stores stuffed with objects of desire. After dark, dine in one of the famous rooftop restaurants with stunning harbour and sea views, sampling traditional Turkish delights and international cuisine.

Villa Serpil is located on a small complex of luxury properties designed by an award-winning Turkish architect. Staying at the villa includes complimentary use of their semi Olympic sized swimming pool, restaurant, cocktail bar, and lounge, perfect for meeting up with other holidaymakers and swapping stories and tips.

From the villa it is a short drive into Kalkan, where you can find supermarkets and banks, and a local Thursday market, that can cater for all the provisions you will need for a happy holiday. Take a trip into town, and at the harbour get aboard one of the complimentary water taxis to one of the many exclusive beach clubs. The beach clubs all have bathing platforms, sea views, sun lounger waiter service, restaurants, and bars, and some offer full size swimming pools, water sports, and spa services too. For the beach bunnies, Kalkan has its own pebble beach with organised sun loungers and brollies, easy access into the calm Mediterranean sea, and its own cute cafe. Travel further afield to the stunning Kaputas Beach set in a natural gorge, only two hundred steps down and two hundred steps back up, but well worth it for the scenery and the sea. Take a trip to Patara, where you will find twenty kilometres of unspoilt golden sands, and a protected area for the hatching Caretta Caretta turtles. Patara also boasts an archaeological site over two thousand years old, with not just one but two ancient amphitheatres, not to mention the most stunning sunsets, best seen from the ever-changing sand dunes. No stay in Kalkan is complete without a boat trip from the harbour, whether it's a shared one with family and friends, or you charter your own gulet, a day out at sea with your favourite captain and crew, is one that memories are made of. All aboard for a day of swimming and snorkelling in beautiful bays, enjoy a meal of local homecooked meze, take afternoon tea, and then sail back to harbour cocktail in hand to watch the sunset.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
