Villa do Lago II is situated just 10 minutes away from the inviting region of Montemor-o-Novo, an area that is best recognised for its vast selection of historical monuments. If you are looking to explore this location from an entirely unique and alluring perspective, a trip to Escoural Cave is a real treat. Expressed as both a mesmerising rock structure as well as a fascinating museum, this landmark works tirelessly to educate visitors on the wonders of the Paleolithic era. During their time at this immense establishment, guests will have the prime privilege of observing a range of authentic rock art, giving them a deeper understanding of the Prehistoric roots of this archaic area. Escoural Cave can be found just over 20 minutes away from the villa.

Alongside its far-reaching legacy, this region is also praised for its vast assortment of local wines. These products are made using a plethora of local produce, offering guests a more authentic tasting experience each and every time. A lot of these wines can be found in many of the local bars and restaurants across the local area. Therefore, guests must indulge in a delicious glass of wine as they admire the nuances of the bustling local culture. If you would like to learn more about this industry, you must visit Quinta da Pansel, a riveting local winery that is based around 15 minutes away from Villa do Lago II.

Igreja da Misericórdia is one of the most significant religious landmarks in the entire region and is located just under 10 minutes away from the villa. Equipped with traditional white-washed walls and decorative roof fixtures, this church manages to delight and inspire guests before they even step foot through the front door. First built in 1532, this church also contains a vast statue of Nossa Senhora da Piedade that is crafted entirely from polychrome marble. This unique piece adds a charismatic element of flair to this entire building and exemplifies the region's vast cultural impact. As such, this is a fantastic monument to visit if you are eager to uncover more about Montemor-o-Novo's rich past and how the civilians used religion to guide their moral compasses.
