Montignac, located less than a half hour's drive away, is a must-visit for anyone interested in history and culture. Here you'll find the Lascaux caves, with prehistoric cave paintings that date back over 17,000 years, and a fascinating Romanesque Church. Stroll along the Vézère River, or rent a bike and explore the scenic countryside. Foodies will love the impressive selection of top-rated restaurants and wine bars that serve up mouth-watering local cuisine and fine wines.

Hop in the car and drive around thirty five minutes to Sarlat-la-Canéda, a town steeped in history. To best experience the town, a walking tour of the old town









is highly recommended, as it boasts old architecture, winding streets, and lots of restaurants. Don't miss the opportunity to visit the Gothic Cathédrale Saint-Sacerdos, complete with intricate stained-glass windows, and the Musée de Sarlat et du Périgord Noir, which offers insights into the region's captivating past.

Location & Local Information

Situated just a brief five-minute drive from Terrasson-Lavilledie, Villa Basse is perfectly located for exploring the charms of this quaint small town. The old town is a delight to explore, boasting a wealth of historic buildings and narrow winding streets. Don't miss the Place de la Halles, an expansive market square surrounded by ancient stone structures, or the enchanting Jardins de l'Imaginaire, featuring terraces, water features, and a collection of sculptures. For those who love festivals, Terrasson-Lavilledie has a lot to offer, with events such as the Jazz Festival in July and the Christmas Market in December.

Adventure seekers should rent a canoe from the Terrasson-Lavilledieu, and take a trip down the Dordogne River. The river flows through the countryside and past lots of beautiful villages. There are lots of opportunities to stop off and have a picnic or a coffee from a local café.

Drive less than half an hour to reach Montignac, a lovely village filled with ancient history. The Lascaux caves are a fascinating attraction, showcasing prehistoric cave paintings that date back over 17,000 years. The town also a Romanesque Church, and the Vézère River offers a scenic backdrop for a leisurely stroll. For the more adventurous, renting a bike is a great way to explore the countryside. If you're a foodie, Montignac won't disappoint, with a wide range of top-rated restaurants and wine bars serving up delicious local cuisine and fine wines.

Sarlat-la-Canéda is a unique medieval town, around a thirty five minute drive away. One of the best ways to explore is by taking a walking tour of the old town, which is filled with historic buildings, cobblestone streets, and charming cafés. Visit the Cathédrale Saint-Sacerdos, with its impressive Gothic architecture and stained-glass windows and the Musée de Sarlat et du Périgord Noir, with its captivating artefacts. The town is also known for its vibrant market scene, where you can sample local products like truffles, foie gras, and wine.

If you are feeling adventurous, take a one-hour drive to Gouffre de Padirac, a natural wonder that features a massive sinkhole. After descending via steps or an elevator, you'll have the opportunity to explore a network of underground caves and waterways on a boat tour. Along the way, you'll be amazed by geological formations and underground waterfalls, including the Grand Dôme, a cavern adorned with striking stalactites and stalagmites.
