Overview

Tucked away in the blissful Tuscan countryside just a ten-minute drive from the beach, this authentic villa is perfect for those who love to spend time outdoors. Villa Bei Giardini is situated on the outskirts of Tarquinia, making it the ideal base to explore the captivating city, which is also a Word Heritage site.

Inside the villa, you will find a big living room with a fireplace in its centre, great for evenings when you want to snuggle up with a book or watch TV. The interior has an authentic Italian style, with terracotta tiles, exposed wooden features, and comfortable furnishings giving it a homely feel. If you feel like a bite to eat, the modern kitchen has everything you need to cook up something delicious.

The exterior of this villa feels like an outdoor oasis. Take a dip in the heated pool, complete with an outdoor shower, or soak up the rays in one of the sunloungers that surround it. The extra-large loggia provides the comfort of the indoors with the open-air space of the outdoors. Here you can indulge in meals al-fresco while enjoying the serene atmosphere. For those seeking romantic moments of solitude, a smaller loggia, with lovely trellises framing the area, is situated at the rear of the villa.

From Villa Bei Gardini, you can access a lovely beach via a private road, in just a ten-minute drive. Explore the region's beautiful coastline, made up of sandy shoreline and rugged cliff sides dotted with bars and restaurants. If you want to make home-cooked meals back at the villa, the nearest supermarket is ten minutes away by car.

A UNESCO World Heritage site, the city's necropolis are home to a vast collection of ancient tombs adorned with frescoes and decorations. A gorgeous beach is easily accessible from Villa Bei Gardini through a private road and a mere ten-minute drive away. Along the coastline, you can marvel at the stunning mix of sandy beaches and rough cliffs, lined with various bars and restaurants. If you prefer preparing your own meals, the closest supermarket is just a ten-minute drive from the villa.

Villa Bei Gardini sits on the outskirts of Tarquinia, a charming city famous for its ancient history. Explore the tombs spread through the necropolis, which UNESCO recognises as a World Heritage site due to their significance in Etruscan history and culture. Marvel at the intricate frescoes and decorations that adorn their walls. To discover more about the area's rich history, visit the fascinating National Museum of Tarquinia, which displays an impressive collection of sculptures, ceramics, and other objects that provide insight into the Etruscan way of life.


After all that exploring, head to Lido di Tarquinia, a picturesque sandy shore with crystal-clear water. Sample some local dishes at one of the restaurants, such as *spaghetti alla carbonara, porchetta*, and *fettuccine al ragù*.

In just half an hour, you can drive to Maremma Natural Park, an idyllic escape from city life. The park's pristine landscapes feature diverse flora and fauna, including deer, wild boar, and rare bird species. Explore the park's winding trails on foot, bike, or horseback, taking in vistas of rolling hills, forests, and unspoiled beaches along the way. The park is also home to several historic sites, such as Magliano's medieval town and Roselle's ancient Etruscan ruins, offering a glimpse into the region's rich cultural heritage.

Drive 35 minutes to Civitavecchia, a seaside city full of restaurants, cafes and striking architecture. The charming city revolves around a 2nd-century port, which still has several historical attributes, such as the old Roman Dock and the 16th-century Michelangelo Fort. It is also home to several beaches where you can relax on the sandy shores, swim in crystal-clear waters, or enjoy water sports such as snorkelling and scuba diving.
