# Location & Local Information



The nation of Antigua and Barbuda is made up of two sister islands and several smaller islets, all situated in the heart of the Caribbean. Blissful beaches are only the beginning of all that the beautiful, friendly island of Antigua has to offer. Only a forty-minute drive away from Carlisle Bay, a visit to the Antiguan capital of St. John's comes highly recommended. Here you will find the white twin towers of St. John's Cathedral, as well as the Museum of Antigua and Barbuda, providing a fascinating look at the island's heritage and history. Visit the harbour at St. John's over the weekend, and chances are you will find yourself wandering through a lively local market.

Famed as the sailing capital of the Caribbean, the picturesque marinas of English Harbour and Falmouth Harbour can easily be reached within half an hour by car. Here you can watch superb yachts come and go whilst soaking up the vibrant atmosphere that Antigua's southern coastline has to offer. For those who wish to experience the magic for themselves, there are plenty of sailing excursions, boat tours and other exhilarating water-based activities available. Visitors can arrange to charter a private boat or take a guided trip around the island's spectacular reefs and secluded coves.

The magnificent Nelson's Dockyard National Park is one of five national parks in Antigua. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, this eighteenth-century British naval dockyard is an area of great historical significance, as well as a popular venue for maritime events and activities. From Nelson's Dockyard, hike to Shirley Heights, another popular destination on the island. A restored military lookout, this is a spot known for its bewitching views and community feel. With a popular street party happening every Sunday afternoon, visitors are welcome to enjoy the music of live Caribbean steel drum bands, taste some of the local food and rum punch and take in the breathtaking sights as the sun begins to go down on the stunning island of Antigua.

There are plenty of fantastic trekking trails around the island, taking in sandy beaches, rainforests and dreamlike coastal views. For a challenging hike, put on your hiking shoes and visit Mount Obama, Antigua's highest peak. From the summit, enjoy the panoramic views before descending to Cades Bay for a delightfully refreshing dip in the ocean.

Back at Carlisle Bay, the resort's exceptional facilities include a gorgeous swimming pool, a pristine beach, nine tennis courts and an exciting watersports centre, as well as a fully equipped gym and a luxury spa. Should you wish to spend a relaxing evening close to home, many excellent restaurants are available for you to visit, with something to cater to everyone's taste. Return to the Ocean Suite feeling refreshed and indulged before a night under the stars on your private terrace.
