Overview

An early twentieth-century villa just a stone's throw from the glorious white beaches and crystal clear waters of northwest Sicily, Fiori di Mondello majestically embodies the Art Nouveau style synonymous with this culturally vibrant region.

Every inch of Fiori di Mondello oozes class, from its painstakingly maintained Liberty Style exterior and bold colouration, elaborate tapestries and sinuous, wrought-iron staircase balustrades to touches of modern luxury like the rainfall showers, air conditioning and pool with mountainside views from its terrace. The blend of attention to detail, respect paid to the original structure and delivery of absolute luxury is quite astonishing, with each area of this lavish home conveying the same message - "relax and enjoy yourself; it's beautiful here". Truly a bouquet for the senses, a stay at the aptly named Fiori di Mondello is an unforgettable, enchanting experience.

Five delightful, air-conditioned bedrooms await up to ten guests here, each boasting impossibly comfortable queen-size beds and superior-quality en-suite bathrooms. The bedrooms (three in the main villa, two in its annexe) enjoy garden or terrace access, with the pièce de résistance found on the first floor. There are beautiful views to wake to, and then there is this – the grand spectacle of the cliffs of Capo Gallo and the clear waters that meet the curvaceous Spiaggia di Mondello, all positioned beyond your intricately manicured garden, with its towering Mediterranean trees adding detail to this astonishing vista.

Your living space here is utterly exquisite, with preserved architectural details complemented by exquisite ornamentation and furniture as comfortable as it is tasteful. A floor-to-ceiling bookcase draws the eye to the stunning orangery with a dining table beyond, opening to a beautiful garden. Look up from your sumptuously comfortable sofa and admire the high ceiling's intricate cornices, with a vast fireplace occupying wall space permitted by the huge portesfenêtres that flood the lounge with glorious natural light.

For all the careful preservation and enhancement of this home's original features, there is no compromise on modern functionality and comfort. The design and configuration use these features to maximise its contemporary elements, the kitchen being a superb example. This room becomes an exciting playground for any visiting gourmet when you factor in the wealth of incredible food available – not least at Palermo's famous food markets. A sleek central island comprises an integrated sink and induction hob, a brilliant white finish









matched by the gorgeous cabinets, and a sunlit by substantial patio doors adjacent to a family-sized dining table. This kitchen has top-end appliances and a recessed wine rack that you're almost duty-bound to load with some of the region's fabulous bottles.

Outside the kitchen, you'll find an outdoor space as painstakingly designed as the villa. Immaculate lawns that would grace a snooker table are stylishly punctuated by tall palms, with views of a beach that's only a short walk from your door. The colossal trees provide invaluable shade on hot days, with the private pool's submerged steps beckoning you to cool off in style. Of course, the outdoor dining area is a special place to enjoy meals together, with panoramic views from the terrace adding another layer of pure delight to your days and nights at the magnificent Fiori di Mondello.

Perfect for beach lovers, the seaside district of Mondello welcomes thousands of visitors to its silky sands and crystal clear waters each year. In a region renowned for both its cuisine and cultural heritage, you won't fail to be impressed by either. Just a short walk between Fiori di Mondello and the Beach is a sandwich shop whose owner is often known to burst into impromptu song and dance routines – the sandwiches are delicious, too! The stunning city of Palermo is just a few kilometres away, with more incredible Liberty Style architecture, beautiful restaurants and eclectic street markets to explore.

Location & Local Information

Visitors to the Sicilian capital of Palermo cannot fail to be awestruck by the spectacular Art Nouveau architecture that adorns its streets and squares. The Palazzo dei Normanni, or the Royal Palace, Palazzo Sant'Elia and Teatro Massimo – the largest theatre in Italy – are absolute must-sees.


Just as jaw-dropping are the mountain views and coastal vistas that encircle this sophisticated and vibrant city and Mondello to the north, a few minutes walk from Fiori di Mondello, the Beach is a phenomenal expanse of white sand that meets the Mediterranean's beautiful, electric blue waters. Just as in Palermo, you'll find a fantastic selection of bars, cafés, street food vendors and even Michelin-starred restaurants close to the Beach. In addition to fresh seafood, local highlights include pasta alla norma (a savoury pasta with aubergines, tomatoes and basil) and arancini (fried risotto balls stuffed with meats and cheeses).

Separated by only seven kilometres – and the imposing Montepellegrino - from the Sicilian capital, Mondello attracts visitors worldwide. The town is home to the World Festival on the Beach, a celebration of water sports events. It's an appropriate location for the event, in a town whose nautical clubs have produced numerous Olympic champions. However, don't let that stop you from trying kiteboarding for the first time – you'll find plenty of watersports tutorials along the kilometre-and-a-half-long Beach!

For a more sedate experience, the white beaches at Mondello are perfect for sunbathing as you fancy, with the nearby nature reserve of Capo Gallo just beautiful for a coastal walk – don't forget your sea shoes!
