Chalet Laney is ideally located in the heart of Val d'Isère, a popular Alpine skiing resort, with excellent access to amenities and the wider area should you wish to explore.

Getting to the chalet is straightforward and simple as Val d'Isère is well-served by its transport links. The area is easily accessible by road, with major airports in cities such as Geneva and Lyon, both of which are around a two-and-a-half hours' drive away. The resort is also connected to the French rail network, with regular services to Bourg-Saint-Maurice, which is the nearest train station.

While Val d'Isère is primarily a ski resort, the surrounding area has grown to accommodate a number of popular pastimes. In the village, you'll find a charming atmosphere with a world-class range of restaurants, bars, and shops, as well as a weekly market selling local produce and handicrafts.

You'll also be able to try your hand at a wide variety of activities beyond skiing, such as snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and ice skiing. Or, you can take a break from physical activities and book a relaxing spa experience at one of the resort's many wellness centres.
