Outdoors, the garden is your own oasis, with lush lawns, trees and floral planting. Although you are located close to the town centre, you can completely unwind in this vast, serene garden. The home even has a hydromassage pool to indulge in an afternoon dip.

The two main towns on the island of Capri are Anacapri and Capri town, both of which are 4km away or less. Anacapri is the closest town, just a short walk from the house. It has fine dining eateries, brilliant shopping opportunities, and amazing views over the marina.

Location & Local Information

Located within a lush, green garden with views over the sea, Villa Amarelle enjoys a perfect setting from which you can explore the town of Anacapri, which is on your doorstep, or drive to Capri town, which is just 4km away. With restaurants, beaches and historic attractions nearby, this ancient villa is a beautiful place to stay.

The exclusive island of Capri is known for its dramatic coastline, boutique shops and upscale eateries. It is a firm favourite with holiday-makers who flock here to experience this beautiful island for themselves. Set in the Bay of Naples, the island is easy to reach from the mainland but has its own charm and character for you to discover.

The island boasts two main towns, Anacapri and Capri, offering cafés, bars, restaurants, and attractions. The closest town to the villa is Anacapri, a short stroll away. This smaller, authentic island town is less crowded than Capri but offers many amenities. Anacapri is an atmospheric, whitewashed town below the imposing Monte Solaro. For some of the best views on the island, you can head up the peak by chair lift. This ride takes under 15 minutes, and once at the top, you can see right across the island and the surrounding sea. The centre of Anacapri has a great range of restaurants and shops and historical sights such as churches and Casa Rossa, a period house and museum. If you prefer an afternoon of hiking, you can hike through the trails around Monte Solaro or climb the 1000 steps leading towards Capri town.

The glamorous, lively Capri town is just 4km away and can be reached by car or as part of a long walk. This fantastic town is the island's main centre, filled with designer and boutique shops and a vast range of cafés, restaurants and bars. The town sits on an elevated platform looking out over the yacht-filled marina and the rest of the island. While in town, you can wander the picturesque streets and do a spot of shopping. There are also scenic walking routes and parks to explore, such as the Augustus Gardens which offer a welcome break from the town centre on busy days. Nearby, you can also visit historic attractions such as the beautiful Villa Lysis or walk to the famous Villa Jovis, which Roman Emperor Tiberius owned.

In addition to the towns, Capri is home to mountainous walking trails and an array of pristine beaches. Many beaches near the home are pretty, pebbled coves, although you can also find sandy beaches at Faraglioni and Bagni di Tiberio. You should also make sure to visit the incredible Blue Grotto cave which is nestled in the rocky shoreline.

- Due to being located on the island of Capri, a ferry is required to reach this property. Ferries from Naples to Capri depart from two ports: the Molo Beverello and the Calata Porta di Massa. Ferries for Capri depart from Sorrento's Marina Piccola port. High speed ferries for Capri depart from Positano, Amalfi, and Salerno. Routes are only active during the summer from April through October.
- There are two entrances to the home, one of which is a pedestrian-only entrance while the other can be accessed by car, a rarity on Capri.

- Security deposit: €2000 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
