

Apartment Quattro Stagioni

Overview

You'll be impressed by the sense of space when you stay at Apartment Quattro Stagione, perfectly positioned near the Spanish Steps and in the heart of central Rome, the capital city of Italy.

This two-hundred square metre apartment has four huge bedrooms and can comfortably accommodate up to nine guests, ideal for a large family holiday or friends' get-together. The apartment is on the third floor of a Roman noble townhouse and has a lift to take you there.

Apartment Quattro Stagione comes complete with complimentary air conditioning, Wi-Fi, and satellite television to watch your favourite films. The interiors are elegant, with modern parquet flooring and high ceilings, furnished with classical formal pieces, a scattering of decorative antiques, and adorned with crystal chandeliers.

Take the elevator to the third floor, welcoming you to your light and airy holiday home from home. The light wood floor sitting room has a crystal chandelier, a comfy cream sofa, two baby blue upholstered armchairs, two formal red fabric armchairs, and an apricot velvet chair arranged around a coffee table facing a flat-screen television.

Go down the hallway to a black and white, contemporary kitchen fully equipped with all the built-in appliances you will need to cater for your holiday. The kitchen is home to a six-seater dining set, ideal for enjoying breakfast before a day's sightseeing. A long corridor has four large well-appointed bedrooms leading off it.

The master bedroom has a queen size bed and an arched room with bookcases full of books and a working desk. There are two more bedrooms with queen-sized beds and one with three single beds, perfect for children to share. The apartment has three superb big bathrooms, each with a different decorative theme, one with striking monochrome tiles, a double vanity unit, a bathtub with a shower, and one with burgundy and white tiles, a glass-fronted walk-in shower, a mirrored vanity unit, WC, and bidet.

Location & Local Information

Apartment Quattro Stagione can be found near the Spanish Steps, nestled in the heart of central Rome, the capital city of Italy. The apartment is just fourteen kilometres from Rome's international Leonardo Da Vinci Airport, which can be reached by taxi or train. The central Roma Termini train station is five minutes to Barberini, the nearest metro station; hop into a taxi, or pre-book a transfer with the concierge team. There is something for everyone to enjoy when you holiday in Rome - whether it's ancient history, architecture, renaissance art, culture, food, shopping, and fashion or the simple joy of people watching, the Eternal City has got a lot.

Step outside the apartment, and within a short distance, you are sipping cappuccinos in the bustling square of Piazza Barberini; make a wish at the famous sculpted marble Trevi fountain, then take a walk to the impressive and iconic Spanish steps. Everywhere you go, there are ornate churches, rich with decorative icons, don't miss a visit to Santissima Trinita dei Monti, a Roman Catholic late Renaissance church perched above the Spanish Steps. Soak up the history of the city at The Pantheon, the Roman Forum, and the ancient Colosseum, all of which are within walking distance.

No visit to Rome is complete without a meander through the Vatican Museum art collection to see Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel ceiling, the double helix staircase, and the views from the rooftop terraces before visiting the Basilica of St Peter.

For some fine art, go to the Borghese Gallery, set in a gorgeous garden, housing an incredible collection of Canova marble sculptures. On the stroll back, stop at Harry's Bar for a Bellini, then walk down the Spanish steps and visit the Romantic poet Keat's house before sampling English muffins at the famous Babington's Tea Rooms, which has been there since 1893.

Saunter down the oh-so-very fabulous Via dei Condotti and window shop for world-famous designer-label fashion and exquisite hand-crafted leather handbags. Go to the outskirts of the city and cross the Old Appian Way to discover the hidden treasures of the catacombs, join a guided tour, or make your own way there.

If you fancy a day trip out of Rome, the town of Tivoli is only thirty kilometres away, where you can visit Hadrian's Villa and the exquisite Villa D'Este. During the day, dine on freshly made pasta and homemade ice cream, eat alfresco in one of the many squares, sit back, and people watch as the world and the beautiful people pass by. In the evening, make your way to the foodie heaven of Trastevere, and taste the delights of traditional Italian cooking, just like Nonna used to make, in one of its many taverna-style restaurants.
