The bedrooms are decorated simplistically (allowing you to get a great night's sleep) but memorably. More warming wood spills across vibrant yellow and red to create a gentle space. - The alpine climate can cause fluctuating weather conditions. Be prepared for cold weather and pack warm clothing, including thermal layers and insulated jackets. Waterproof clothing is also handy, including waterproof footwear. You will heat up when skiing so have some light base layers ready.
- If you don't own your own gear, or don't want to pack it, you can rent pretty much everything you need, including skies, snowboards, boots, helmets and poles from the local ski store.
- If you're travelling during peak season take some time to make a reservation if there are particular places you want to visit. The area is very popular.
