Overview

Wake up to magnificent mountain views when you vacation in Villa Murat, perfectly positioned between the beautiful beaches of Oludeniz and the cosmopolitan hot spot of Fethiye on Turkey's Turquoise coast. This impressive three-storey, detached villa has four spacious ensuite double bedrooms and can comfortably accommodate up to eight guests, ideal for a family holiday or a group of friends getaway. Traditional stone walls and high fencing surround the villa, giving it a sense of security, privacy, and seclusion. The property is set on its own grounds, with lawned gardens, a centrepiece swimming pool, and a built-in Jacuzzi. Villa Murat comes with complimentary air conditioning, Wi-Fi and a cinema system satellite LCD television. The villa's exterior has classic Mediterranean whitewashed walls, with grey tiled roofing and floor-to-ceiling windows that reward guests with panoramic views. The interiors are stylishly furnished with contemporary pieces, marble floors throughout, and decorated in a neutral colour palette of shades of grey and beige.

Enter the villa at ground floor level, where you will find a light and airy open plan living space with picture window sliding doors that give access to the garden and pool terrace. The seating area has a comfy sofa set, coffee tables, and a flat-screen television. The modern kitchen is fully equipped with all the appliances you will need to cater for your holiday, including that must-have morning coffee maker. A six-seater dining set is just right for some informal indoor entertaining. Take the stairs to the first floor, where you will find two spacious, well-appointed double bedrooms. Both bedrooms have a large double bed, bedside tables, wardrobes, dressing tables, ensuite shower rooms, and glass-fronted balconies. On the second floor, snuggled under the eaves, are a further two bedrooms, both with twin beds, ensuite shower rooms, and sweeping nature view balconies.

Step outside on the tiled terrace, surrounded by well-manicured lawns and home to your own private, step-entry swimming pool. There is a built-in Jacuzzi, which could also be a children's pool and an inset which has strategically positioned sun loungers, so you can dip your toes into the cool water whilst catching up with this year's best seller. Sway the day away in the swing seat, where the children amuse themselves in the play area. As dusk falls, take a seat at the soft seating dining set and enjoy dishes fresh from the barbecue as you raise a toast to the most memorable holiday.


Location & Local Information

Villa Murat sits in the shade of the slopes of Babadag Mountain, in the charming village of Ovacik, near Turkey's Turquoise Coast and the crystal clear waters of the Mediterranean Sea. The property is just over an hour's drive from Dalaman International Airport and ideally located betwixt and between the bustling town of Fethiye and the tourist destinations of Hisaronu and Olu Deniz. Nearby, Hisaronu is a haven of supermarkets, cafes, bars, restaurants, and some super souvenir shops. Take a short drive to Oludeniz, where you will find one of the world's best golden sandy beaches, the iconic and much-photographed blue lagoon and spit, lively seashore restaurants and bars, and exclusive shops. From here, you can hop aboard a water taxi to Butterfly Valley or cross the sea to Gemile Island, aka Aya Nikola, a natural protected area, now an open-air museum.

For the thrill seekers, head up the hill and take the cable car to the top of Mount Babadag, at almost two thousand metres, you can jump off and paraglide solo or in tandem and land on Oludeniz beach. For shopping and the city, Fethiye is your destination. Fethiye is a smart harbour town with yachts moored the length of the coastline, home to an ancient amphitheatre, a historical museum and rock tombs, and an embarkation point for the must-do Twelve Island boat trip. There is a foodie-heaven fish market for a catch of the day fabulous feast, super souvenir shops selling all your favourite designer brands, and a renowned large local market every Tuesday. A walk around the newly paved coastline will take you to the town and beach of Calis, home to more restaurants and bars and a local market.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
