Complimentary air conditioning and Wi-Fi is included throughout, along with secure, on-site parking for your peace of mind, and traditional mosquito nets ensure your comfort during your stay.

At the heart of Villa Feray lies its inviting open-plan living space, stylishly furnished with contemporary pieces and seamlessly connected to the pool terrace and gardens. The inviting seating area has two comfortable sofas, armchairs, a coffee table, side tables, a sideboard, and a large flat-screen television for your entertainment. A swish dining table for six is perfect for indoor entertaining. The fully equipped all-white kitchen caters to your culinary needs, featuring modern built-in appliances, including a dishwasher, washing machine, fridge/freezer, microwave, oven, hob, and dinnerware for twelve guests. A convenient guest cloakroom completes the ground floor.

Take the staircase to the upper floors, where a central atrium with a stunning chandelier floods the villa with lots of natural light. Villa Feray has four well-appointed bedrooms, each furnished with a double bed, bedside cabinets, fitted wardrobes, a vanity table, and an en-suite bathroom with walk-in showers, hand basins, and WCs. All the bedrooms have a private balcony with views of the villa's pool and well-kept garden, offering a peaceful spot to unwind.

The private step-entry swimming pool is surrounded by comfortable sun loungers and shady parasols, perfect for relaxing in the summer sun. Meet under the veranda for cocktails at sunset before feasting alfresco at the outdoor dining set for six, best served with dishes freshly grilled on the barbecue.

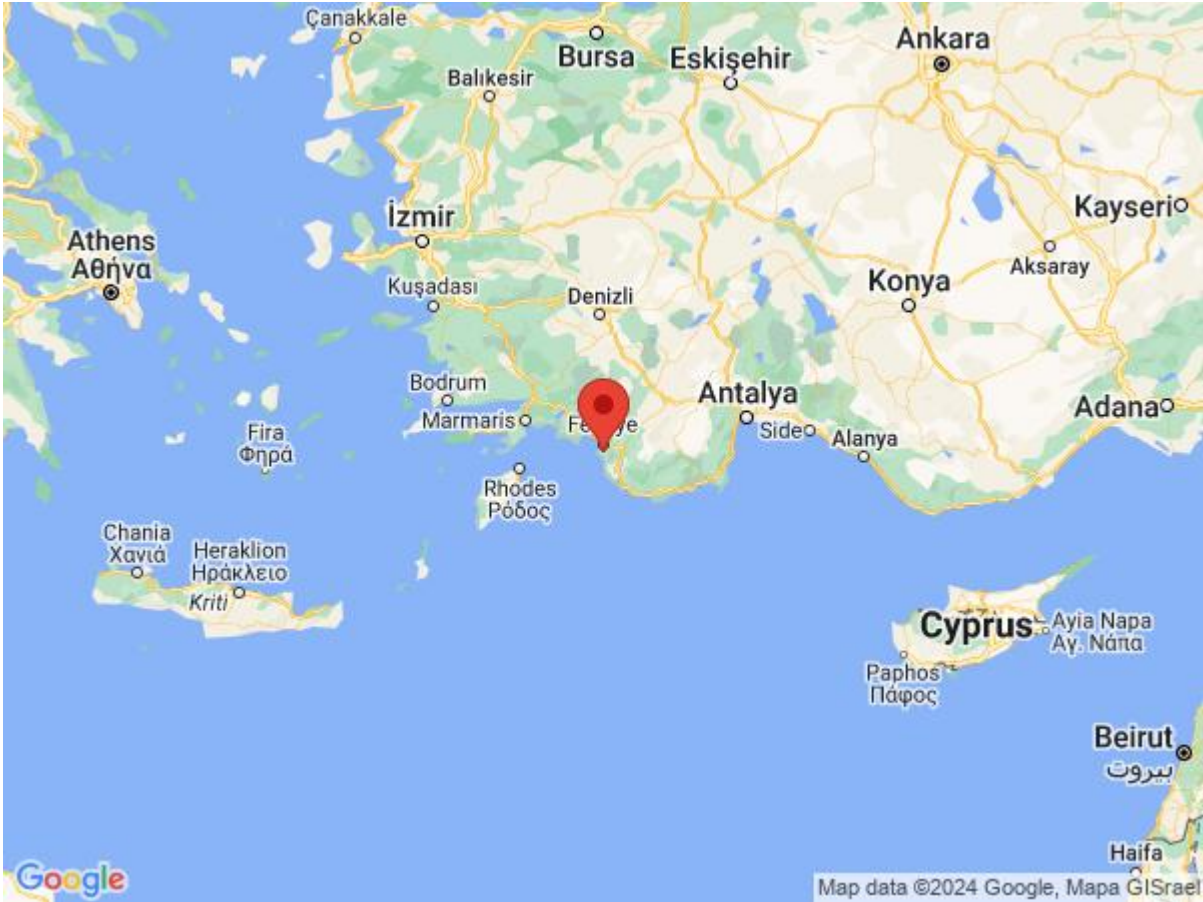
Location & Local Information

Villa Feray is one of four fabulous new build properties in the residential area of the lively resort of Hisaronu. Just under a sixty-kilometre drive from Dalaman International Airport through the Turkish countryside will take you to your holiday home. The villa is perfectly situated betwixt and between the bustling town of Fethiye and the desirable resort destination of Oludeniz, both only fifteen minutes away. For holiday provisions, local shops and restaurants are a short walk away. Hisaronu is home to a host of supermarkets, cafes, bars, and restaurants, a busy nightlife, and some super souvenir shops too.

Take a short drive down to Oludeniz, where you will find one of the world's best blue flag, golden sandy beaches, the iconic and much-photographed blue lagoon and spit, offering a selection of adrenalin-inducing water sports. In the evening, the town comes alive with buzzing seashore restaurants and bars and a chance to indulge in some exclusive shopping. From Oludeniz, you can hop aboard a water taxi to Butterfly Valley or cross the sea to Gemile Island. For the thrill seekers, head up the hill and take the cable car to the top of Mount Babadag, and paraglide back down to Oludeniz beach.

For shopping and the city, Fethiye is your go-to destination, a harbour town with yachts moored the length of the coastline, home to an ancient amphitheatre, a historical museum and rock tombs, and an embarkation point for the obligatory Twelve Island boat trip. There is a foodie-heaven fish market, souvenir shops selling your favourite designer brands, and a local Tuesday market.

Culture can be found in ancient ruins and historic sites along the Lycian Way, take a walk in nature and discover the area's local flora and fauna.

- Villa Feray is one of four identical villas, great if there's a large group or family celebration travelling together, however please note that as the pictures are the same views and furnishings may differ slightly.

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: £200 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- Arrival time: 4.00 p.m.
- Departure time: 10.00 a.m.
- Energy costs included?: Yes, included in the rental price.
- Heating costs included?: Yes, included in the rental price.
- Linen & towels included?: Yes, included in the rental price.
- End of stay cleaning included?: Yes. An extra cleaning fee of £70 - £100 is required for stays under 7 nights. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- Internet access?: Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on the local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- Minimum stay: 5 nights.
- Changeover day: Flexible.
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed.
- Smoking Allowed?: Smoking & Vaping are not permitted.
- Tax: Included in the rental price.
- Insurance: Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, loss of personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- Other Ts and Cs: Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- Other 2: In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases, a bathroom bin is provided.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government [Website](#) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
