Location & Local Information


A vibrant seaside town with an abundance of Dalmatian charm, Makarska lies along the stunning Makarska Riviera, which stretches from Split to Dubrovnik on Croatia's sun-drenched Adriatic coastline. While a treasure trove of scenic beaches is often seen as the town's main attraction, Makarska offers visitors a distinctive cultural heritage, excellent gastronomic experiences, beautiful architecture and diverse landscapes to enjoy.

After a morning spent lounging by your own private pool, take an afternoon stroll along the town's pretty promenade before wandering the cobblestone streets of the old town to the main square. Here, you will find beautiful St. Mark's Church with its spectacular mountain backdrop, as well as plenty of charming cafes and restaurants. Stop for a coffee and watch the world go by before enjoying a leisurely lunch of fresh seafood or Makarska pašticada, a traditional regional beef dish. During the summer months, the picturesque squares of Makarska come alive, with local festivals and music events taking place in the old town.

For something a little different, visit the town's astronomical observatory, a striking building located on a green hill in the town centre, where the conditions are ideal for stargazing. The observatory is open from June to September, offering visitors the opportunity to learn more about the magic of the night sky from a truly unique setting. For a glimpse into Makarska's colourful past, visit the historic Franciscan Monastery near the harbour, home to a baroque bell tower, an impressive art gallery and an extensive library of rare books. A magnificent contemporary mosaic behind the altar attracts many visitors to the monastery, while the Shell Museum, located on the grounds, displays a collection of over three thousand seashells from around the world.

Lively Makarska Beach stretches for almost two kilometres, from the harbour out to the western side of the town. Water sports enthusiasts will be delighted by the facilities on offer here, while the promenade offers plenty of cafes, bars and ice cream shops, which are enjoyed by locals and visitors alike. For those in search of more secluded shores, Nugal Beach provides a pristine coastline sheltered by rocky cliffs, which can only be accessed on foot or by boat. The crystal-clear waters of nearby Solaric Beach are ideal for swimming and snorkelling, while the beach at Biloševac on the northern edge of Makarska is easily accessible, surrounded by fragrant pine trees and great for families and groups of friends.

For a day trip to remember, hop on a boat to the enchanting island of Bra?, where more breathtaking beaches and scenic coastal towns can be reached in just under an hour. Catamaran tours also take in the stunning natural beauty of Kor?ula and Mljet, while Hvar is another popular option. Meanwhile, closer









to home, hikers and nature lovers will be keen to explore the limestone peaks of Biokovo, the majestic mountain range that forms the spellbinding backdrop to Makarska.
