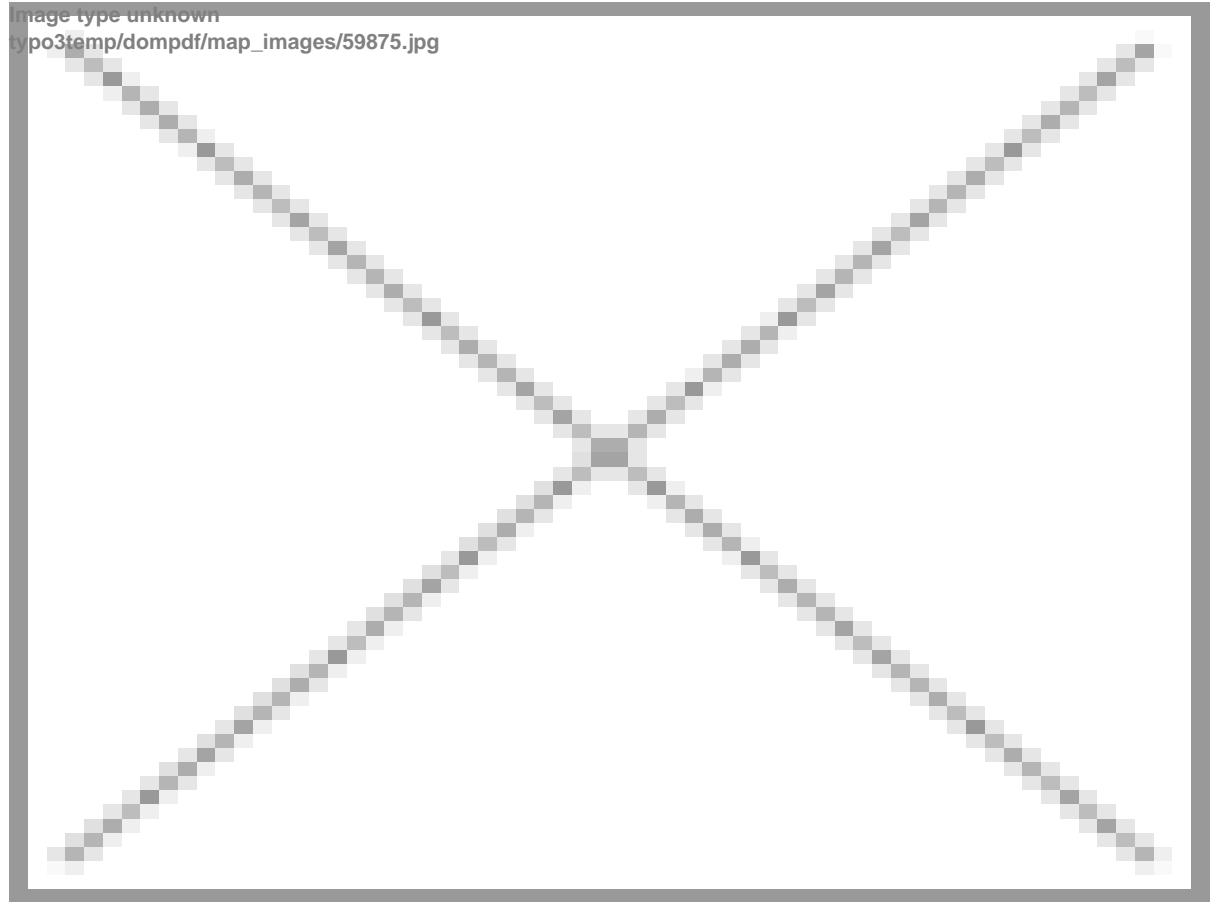

Visit the Badia di Passignano monastery nearby, walk around the quaint village of Sambuca or visit one of the nearby wineries and restaurants. When you need to complete your grocery shopping, Arezzo will cater to your needs with a handful of shops and supermarkets.

As you journey through Chianti's vineyards, discover the birthplace of the world-famous Chianti Classico wine. Tour historic wineries and savour tastings of Sangiovese and other varietals amid breathtaking landscapes. But Chianti's beauty extends beyond its vineyards. Immerse yourself in the lush Chianti Hills, where hiking and cycling trails offer scenic vistas, picnic by serene lakes or take a rejuvenating dip in natural springs.

If you wish to visit captivating towns and cities, why not start your journey in Florence? In just 45 minutes by car, you can visit all the rare beauty of the cradle of the Renaissance. Explore the Uffizi Gallery, where Botticelli's "The Birth of Venus" and Michelangelo's "David" come to life. Stroll across the iconic Ponte Vecchio bridge, and don't forget to visit the magnificent Florence Cathedral. In the evenings, savour a Tuscan feast with renowned Chianti Classico wines at a local trattoria.

Alternatively, both Siena and Arezzo are just a 1-hour drive away. Notably, Arezzo is a town steeped in history and renowned for its antique market, La Fiera Antiquaria. Admire the stunning frescoes by Piero della Francesca in the Basilica of San Francesco and wander the quaint streets of the old town – you'll soon witness that Arezzo's rich cultural heritage is a testament to its enduring allure.

Siena, a UNESCO World Heritage site, beckons with its mediaeval majesty. Visit the iconic Piazza del Campo, home to the thrilling Palio horse race, and marvel at the Gothic splendour of Siena Cathedral. The historic centre's winding alleys lead to hidden treasures and local trattorias offering delectable Tuscan cuisine.
