Puglia's popularity with holidaymakers extends to much more than warm sunshine. Mediterranean landscapes and mouth-watering cuisine and staving in Casa Aragonesi allows you to effortlessly explore this region's famous white towns, which gleam from hilltops throughout the Valle d'Itria.

Begin your adventure in Alberobello, a UNESCO World Heritage site celebrated for its iconic Trulli houses. Wander through Rione Monti, where these cone-shaped dwellings form a fairytale landscape and don't miss Trullo Sovrano, the only two-story Trullo. Here you can immerse yourself in the unique history and culture of these whimsical structures.


Monopoli's picturesque coastline beckons with crystal-clear waters and a charming old port - plus it's just a 10-minute drive away. Spend leisurely days on sandy beaches or explore the historic center's quaint streets where you can soak up vitamin D and grab a delicious gelato. When you're in need, there's also a large supermarket here and a couple of grocery and local shops for your convenience. The closest restaurant can be reached in comfortable 20 minutes by foot, with a road snaking through fields and vineyards.

For those looking for the hustle and bustle. Bari combines coastal elegance with timeless allure. Stroll along the seafront promenade to admire the Adriatic's glistening waters and explore the historic Old Town (Bari Vecchia), home to the Basilica di San Nicola and the captivating Swabian Castle. In the height of summer, there are plenty of street festivals happening all around, allowing you to sample local street food delights, like focaccia and orecchiette pasta, at bustling markets.

Nearby, Polignano a Mare enchants with its clifftop charm. Wander the historic center's narrow streets, savoring breathtaking sea views, relax on pebble beaches and visit the mesmerising (and Instagram famous) seaside cave restaurant that is nothing short of enchanting.

If you're still hungry for more exploring, conclude your journey in Brindisi, a city steeped in maritime history. Explore ancient Roman columns along the seafront promenade and visit the magnificent Cathedral of Brindisi completed in 1143 and decorated with a fascinating light display at night. Only a 1-hour drive away, this busy city is a getaway to Albania and Greece, with ferries leaving from its only port.

In Puglia, you'll discover a rich tapestry of history, culture, and natural beauty. Whether you're wandering the Trulli-lined streets of Alberobello, basking on
