

From here, it's just a short drive to Parco dell'Etna, a 58-hectare national park established in 1987 featuring caves, wildlife, and Mount Etna, an active volcano. With abundant guided and independent walking routes, it's an excellent way to exercise and breathe fresh air. For those who make it to the top, sweeping island views await.
