## **Location & Local Information**

Salina, an Aeolian Island off Sicily's coast, is a verdant paradise, famed for its lush landscapes, captivating sea views, and rich cultural tapestry, offering an authentic Italian escape.

The villa resides in the heart of Malfa, a small town on the north coast from where you can easily access all of the beautiful areas of the island. An array of restaurants is right at your doorstep, with the closest one being less than a brisk, 1-minute walk away. The supermarket brimming with fresh local produce and quality groceries is also just a short stroll away for your convenience. On a hot sunny day, grab your swimming essentials and head to the beach – both of the local beaches are easy to get to by car or on foot. Notably, Spiaggia dello Scario has interesting rock formations and crystal-clear water you'll love snorkelling in. For an alternative form of exercise, walk up to the village's cemetery and bask in splendid ocean views from the top.

In the neighbouring village of Pollara, you'll find more charming delis and restaurants, as well as beaches to discover. Spiaggia di Pollara has tiny rock houses built into the mountain, and on the way there you can stop at one of the island's many vantage points Punto Panoramico di Pollara which grants breathtaking views. If you'd like to admire nature from the sea, why not jump on an organised trip or rent a motorboat for a tour around the island? Stop at the Insenatura nella roccia caves and see the Arco naturale di pietra - II Perciatino arch before taking a dip at one of the hidden beaches nearby. Those who want to get to know the area better on foot can try one of the many walking and hiking paths and get all the way to observation docks such as the Monte dei Porri.

Alternatively, head to the largest town and discover the charm of Santa Marina Salina, a jewel in the Aeolian Islands of Sicily. Stroll along its picturesque marina, lined with colourful boats and bustling cafés, perfect for sipping local Malvasia wine, or explore the quaint streets, dotted with artisan shops offering unique crafts and delicacies. Don't miss the panoramic views from the Church of Santa Marina, a photographer's dream. For a taste of adventure, hike to the verdant Monte Fossa delle Felci, revelling in breathtaking vistas along the way. Santa Marina Salina is a delightful blend of serene beauty and vibrant Sicilian culture, a must-visit for any island explorer. From here, you can hop on the ferry to other nearby islands such as the neighbouring Lipari, Vulcano Porto or Catania.
