Ascending to the first floor, guests will discover the music room adorned with a stunning baby grand piano, along with four of the seven tastefully appointed bedrooms. Each bedroom is individually styled with antique furniture and offers en-suite bathrooms with either showers or elegant roll-top baths. The Sir James Hobart suite, named after the man who built Hales Hall and served as the attorney general to King Henry VII, features a regal king-size bed and an en-suite bathroom with a luxurious roll-top bath. The Countess of Suffolk suite boasts a king-size bed, an en-suite wet room, a feature fireplace, and oak floors, exuding timeless charm. Prudence offers a comfortable double bed and an en-suite shower room, while Dionysia boasts a brass king-size bed, an en-suite bathroom featuring a roll-top bath, and its own secluded reading room.

On the second floor, guests can relax in the Longe Room, featuring a sumptuous super king-size bed and an en-suite bathroom with a roll-top bath and shower, providing splendid views of the garden and the scenic countryside. The Sir Peter Read suite offers another luxurious sanctuary with a super king-size bed and an en-suite bathroom featuring a roll-top bath and shower. The Sir Francis Bacon suite, named after the renowned Elizabethan nobleman, features a king-size bed and an en-suite bathroom with a roll-top



bath and shower, combining historical elegance with modern comfort.

Surrounded by six acres of meticulously maintained gardens, Laddon Hall offers a haven for nature enthusiasts and leisure seekers alike.
