If you are looking for the ideal base for exploring the beautiful Chianti region in Tuscany, Villa Bastiano is a fantastic choice. This recently restored historic home is a haven for exploring charming local villages and vineyards. The villa is surrounded by lush countryside and offers tranquillity amidst olive groves and fragrant fruit trees, providing a serene backdrop for your Italian escape.

Just 4km away lies the quaint village of Lecchi in Chianti, a perfect starting point for scenic walks and cycling through hillside trails bordered by ancient oak trees. Lecchi also offers access to natural spring pools in the nearby forests, ideal for a refreshing swim on warm days.

A 3km drive from the villa takes you to the well-preserved Castello di Ama, a medieval castle with Etruscan origins. Now used as a vast vineyard, it welcomes visitors for vineyard and cellar tours and wine tastings. Art enthusiasts will be happy here as you can explore contemporary art installations within the castle's stunning grounds.

For a more considerable town experience, why not venture 8km to Radda in Chianti? Once the headquarters for the Chianti League in the Middle Ages, Radda boasts an impressive town hall, historic town walls, and a variety of shops and eateries. Delve into cookery classes, explore medieval castles, or visit the unique Cashmere goat farm for a memorable Chianti adventure.

In addition to exploring the enchanting allure of Chianti and the wonderful countryside. You are also conveniently located for day trips to Siena and Florence, two of Tuscany's most captivating cities. Siena, the closest city, is a mere 30km from the villa. Notable attractions in Siena include the Gothic town hall and the intricate cathedral, offering a splendid day of strolls through this breathtaking city. Florence, situated 60km away, is a must-visit for art and history enthusiasts, showcasing a wealth of cultural treasures that beckon exploration. Both cities should make your itinerary as they are truly unmissable.
