The period property boasts woodburning oven, wooden ceiling beams, and traditional terracotta floor tiles that echo centuries of character. Antique artworks and furnishings adorn the interiors, creating an ambience steeped in history. Rich colour palettes and garden views grace the cosy rooms, offering a warm and inviting atmosphere. The house unfolds over two levels, each featuring living spaces, bedrooms, a porch or covered sunroom, a comfortable living room with a woodburning oven, a fully-fitted kitchen, and a dining area.

Reflecting a thoughtful layout, the villa functions like two apartments, providing privacy for two families or groups. The six double bedrooms, spread across both floors, each offer a unique charm and come complete with en-suite bathrooms.


With wide-open countryside and a range of gorgeous towns on your doorstep, you are ideally placed to discover all Tuscany has to offer while on holiday here. The house sits on the grounds of a vast wine estate, so if you are a winelover, you can tour the cellars and production areas and participate in wine tastings. You can also access walking trails and scenic picnic spots outside the gated gardens.


If you love to spend your days exploring a vibrant city, consider a 6km drive to Arezzo. This ancient city, with roots dating back over 1000 years, evolved from a modest Etruscan settlement into a bustling trading hub. Steeped in history, Arezzo endured battles between Siena and Florence, resulting in the imposing fortress rebuilt by the Medici in the 16th century. Today, it houses a museum with dynamic art exhibitions. Explore sights like the National Museum of Medieval and Modern Art and the Basilica of Saint Francis, adorned with captivating frescoes. Enjoy the city's cafe culture, stroll through charming streets, and savour diverse dining options for a delightful evening.

A little further out, you can also visit the picturesque town of Anghiari. 33km from the villa, this friendly and welcoming town is considered one of Tuscany's most beautiful walled towns. Rooted in medieval history, the town prospered through the skills of weavers, ceramicists, and accomplished woodworkers, a legacy that endures today. Its streets are alive with art studios, antique shops, and artisanal craft stores, complemented by a museum dedicated to these traditional crafts. Atmospheric town squares host many shops, cafes, and restaurants alongside architectural gems like the 7th-century Church of Santo Stefano and grand palaces, including the Palazzo del Marzocco. This palace, now a museum, delves into the historical Battle of Anghiari in 1440, a conflict between Florence and Milan.

Every visit to this part of Tuscany is complete with a day trip to Florence, just 80km away. Within a 90-minute drive, you can find yourself enjoying a glass of wine in the iconic Piazza della Signoria. Florence, an art lover's paradise, hosts world-renowned galleries such as the Galleria dell'Accademia, showcasing Michelangelo's statue of David, and the impressive Uffizi Gallery. A knowledgeable tour guide can enhance your exploration of this culturally rich city, ensuring you uncover its many treasures.
