Location & Local Information

Sitting in the middle of the grounds of an organic vineyard, Villa Pomaio offers guests panoramic views of the verdant hills of Tuscany. Here, you can bask in the sun in the peaceful garden and swim in the private pool with your loved ones.

Positioned strategically amidst the sprawling countryside and near charming towns, your stay at Villa Pomaio provides the perfect base for exploring all that Tuscany and neighbouring Umbria offer. The residence is situated within the grounds of an extensive wine estate, inviting wine enthusiasts to tour cellars, witness the production process, and partake in wine tastings. Just beyond the secure garden gates, long walking trails, pretty picnic spots and a wealth of sporting opportunities await your discovery.

For those who enjoy the vibrancy of city life, a mere 6km drive leads you to the historic city of Arezzo. With a history spanning over a millennium, Arezzo evolved from a modest Etruscan settlement into a bustling trade centre. Battles between Siena and Florence shaped its destiny, culminating in the reconstruction of a formidable fortress by the renowned Medici family in the 16th century. This castle is now a dynamic art museum, a great place to spend the afternoon. In the city, you can also explore landmarks like the National Museum of Medieval and Modern Art and the Basilica of Saint Francis, adorned with centuries-old frescoes. On top of these attractions, you can also access a great selection of shops, cafes, bars and restaurants in Arezzo.

Venturing a bit further, the gorgeous town of Anghiari awaits. 33km away from the villa, this town is well worth the drive. Regarded as one of Tuscany's most beautiful walled towns, Anghiari has a rich medieval history as the town flourished through the talents of local artisans. Its busy streets are home to art studios, antique shops, and craft stores, complemented by a museum of daily life. Picturesque town squares host many shops, cafes, and restaurants, surrounded by architectural treasures such as the 7th-century Church of Santo Stefano and several grand palaces.

A journey to this part of Tuscany remains complete with a day trip to Florence, a mere 80km away. When you visit this incredible city, you can immerse yourself in the iconic Piazza della Signoria, savouring a glass of wine while you soak in the atmosphere. Florence is a haven for art lovers and boasts renowned galleries like the Galleria dell'Accademia, which features pieces such as Michelangelo's statue of David. A great way to see more of the city is to book a guided tour or boat trip along the river.
