
Tuscany's renowned hilltop villages beckon your exploration, and Villa Vernazzano offers an ideal starting point for your adventure. Small villages close to the house, such as Pergaccio and II Passaggio, will provide you with a small range of amenities. Still, for a more comprehensive selection, you should head to Cortona, 9km away by car.

Cortona is a large hilltop village perched 500 meters high, gazing over the awe-inspiring Val di Chiana. Steeped in history dating back to the early Etruscan settlers, Cortona invites you to discover its charms as you wander through cobbled streets, pass through ancient gates and explore bustling squares adorned with historic churches and picturesque buildings, including the 8th-century Palazzo Casali. The former palace now houses a museum packed with artefacts and fascinating exhibitions on local history. You can also stroll through well-preserved ruins in the nearby park. Suppose you plan on spending longer in the village. In that case, you can delve into the vast art collection at the Diocesano Museum and navigate the Fortress del Girifalco, a testament to the craftsmanship of the ruler Cosimo I de Medici. Cortona also offers markets, shops, and restaurants.

Beyond Cortona, the region unfolds with enchanting towns and villages, with Montepulciano at 35km away. This town has over 1500 years of history and is renowned for its wine production, making it an ideal destination for touring local vineyards. Montepulciano's architectural wonders, including the Temple of San Biagio, the Gothic town hall, and the cathedral, promise a captivating journey through time. Beyond its historical sights, Montepulciano is celebrated as a spa town, where natural thermal springs offer visitors restorative properties. Here, you can luxuriate in therapeutic waters and indulge in massages and beauty treatments at a lavish spa, creating a day of ultimate pampering.
