The villa is also in close proximity to Lake Trasimeno, a serene, expansive lake just a 17km drive away. Here you may take lakeside picnics, enjoy leisurely walks along the shoreline, and perhaps even board a boat excursion.

For those seeking history and culture, day trips to nearby cities are easily accessible. Arezzo, a mere 30km drive away, welcomes guests with its rich history and renowned art collections. The Basilica of San Francesco, adorned with frescoes by Piero della Francesca, is a testament to the city's cultural heritage. Perugia is another option at 50km away. With its medieval architecture and vibrant atmosphere, the city beckons visitors to explore its centro storico where you can stroll along the Corso Vannucci, visit the chocolate factory and indulge in local cuisine.
