Location & Local Information



The residence offers an ideal location for immersing yourself in the natural splendours that extend within a 20km radius around the home. Here, you can embark on invigorating hikes through the breathtaking Val di Chiana, indulge in a round of golf on exceptional courses, or sample the exquisite, world-class wines at nearby family-run vineyards.

Additionally, a short distance away lies the enchanting Lake Trasimeno, its crystal-clear waters embraced by wooded trails and sandy lake beaches. This beloved lake is a mere 14km away and provides a haven where you can easily lose yourself for an entire day. Choose from seven distinct beaches, including the inviting Tuoro Beach, catering to sunbathers and those who wish to spend the day making sandcastles. The lake also beckons water sports enthusiasts and offers delightful boat trips around its shores and to the picturesque lake islands.

Beyond the postcard-worthy countryside, Tuscany is celebrated for its hilltop villages, several of which await your exploration during your stay at Villa Cegliolo. While the villa boasts a nearby supermarket and a selection of restaurants within a 1.5km walk, a more extensive array of amenities, including cafes, artisan shops, restaurants, and a vibrant market, can be found in the village of Cortona, just 4km away. Cortona stands as a comprehensive hub, offering everything you might require during your stay, with a wealth of attractions and dining options. History enthusiasts will revel in the ancient remnants, medieval structures, and Renaissance edifices lining the winding cobbled streets. Notable sites include Le Celle Monastery, a 13th-century marvel which was constructed by Saint Francis of Assisi, and the Basilica of Santa Margherita, housing the remains of Saint Margaret. Palaces and castles, like the Fortress del Girifalco commissioned by the Medici Dukes, dot the landscape, complemented by a variety of museums and galleries. The Diocesan Museum is a real highlight and is a treasure trove of Renaissance masterpieces and captivating frescoes.

Those happy to drive a little further out can also take day trips to some incredible cities such as Perugia and Arezzo which each have their own unique characters and a wealth of attractions.
