Overview

On the border of Tuscany and Umbria, Villa Tiravento stands as a serene countryside hideaway, offering a spacious retreat surrounded by the picturesque landscapes of central Italy. The main villa unfolds across three stories, with a welcoming living area adorned with traditional décor and solid wood furnishings, creating a cozy ambiance around the fireplace. Adjoining is a country-style kitchen and dining space, while two roomy double bedrooms and a family bathroom complete this floor. The second level hosts a spacious double room with an en-suite bathroom featuring a shower. The lower ground floor adds another dimension, with a vast sitting room, professional kitchen, and dining room – a perfect space for hosting Italian feasts prepared by a private chef.

The cottage, showcases a more modern aesthetic, offering a ground floor with a comfortable living room with access to a sun-drenched terrace and a fully-fitted kitchen with a dining table for four. Two bedrooms grace this level, one with a double-sized bed and an en-suite bathroom, and another offering a choice of a double-sized bed or two twin beds, accompanied by a separate bathroom with a shower. Ascending to the first floor of the cottage reveals yet another charming double room with its own en-suite shower room.

Stepping outside, a barbecue area invites everyone to gather for alfresco dining against a backdrop of breathtaking rural views. The private pool provides a refreshing oasis, surrounded by various relaxing seating areas strategically placed to soak in the tranquility of the countryside.

On your doorstep here, you can easily reach the surrounding walking and hiking hills, while slightly further out you can find world-class golf courses and even idyllic lake beaches. Those who prefer shopping and dining out to outdoor activities, will delight in trips to ancient villages such as the Etruscan village of Cortona which is a must-visit destination.

Sitting within the picturesque pastures of Tuscany, Villa Tiravento provides an ideal retreat, surrounded by charming countryside and conveniently situated just 3km from the village of Montanare, where you'll find a delightful array of shops and eateries. This splendid villa serves as the perfect launching pad for exploration in this sought-after region.

About 13km away lies the captivating town of Cortona, beckoning with its rich cultural tapestry and historical allure. Here you are able to immerse yourself in the charm of Cortona as you stroll through its winding streets, discovering ancient churches, medieval architecture, and vibrant piazzas. Indulge in the local cuisine at quaint cafes and restaurants, or explore the town's fascinating museums and art galleries. Cortona's elevated position offers breathtaking panoramic views, creating an unforgettable experience for every visitor and earning it the title of one of Italy's most beautiful villages.

Situated 23km away, you can also drive to the large town of Castiglione del Lago. Positioned on a promontory that offers breathtaking views of the serene waters of Lake Trasimeno. While the current town has medieval roots, its origins trace back to the Etruscan era. Emperor Frederick Barbarossa played a significant role in the town's history, overseeing extensive reconstruction during the 13th century to erect the staggering Castello del Leone. Present-day exploration allows visitors to wander through the castle and along the encompassing city walls. Within the castle grounds, an ancient church and an open-air theatre add to the historical charm. Castiglione del Lago offers a plethora of attractions, such as the ornate 16th-century Palazzo della Corgna, the exquisite town hall, and, of course, the castle. The charming streets are lined with numerous artisan shops, cafes, and restaurants, creating a vibrant atmosphere. Just beyond the town walls, visitors can access the beaches of Lake Trasimeno, while ferries await to transport them to the lake's enchanting islands or on scenic boat excursions.

Outdoor enthusiasts will be overjoyed upon discovering the nearby valleys, vineyards and walking trails. Here, you can explore hiking routes, hire bikes, go climbing and even engage in water sports and swimming at Lake Trasimeno. The climate and the idyllic country setting are perfect for getting out and enjoying nature.
