Overview

Set within a tranquil residential hamlet, just 5km outside of Cortona village, lies Villa Scotoni—a warm and inviting residence accommodating 8-10 guests with ease, making it an ideal choice for families or couples traveling together.

Constructed from local stone with terracotta roof tiles, this period farmhouse exudes authentic Tuscan charm. Indoors, the original features such as flooring, fireplaces, and beams have been thoughtfully preserved, offering guests an immersive experience in a genuine Tuscan villa. The house boasts a traditional style with country kitchens, antique furnishings, and solid-wood tables throughout, providing a distinct character that goes beyond typical holiday homes. While maintaining its old-world charm, the villa has been equipped with modern amenities, including air conditioning, coffee machines, TVs, and Wi-Fi for convenience and home comforts.

Spread across multiple floors, each level features its own kitchen, allowing for a flexible use of space akin to separate apartments. The main floor hosts a spacious, fully-fitted kitchen and a large dining room, providing a central gathering space for evening meals and talking the night away. The additional floors include smaller kitchens, dining areas, and cozy living spaces adorned with sofas, TVs, and fireplaces.

The accommodation comprises of four double bedrooms with the option to use two more single bedrooms if needed, all complemented by four well-appointed bathrooms. The rooms are all spacious and overlook the garden, the ideal retreat for a good night's sleep.

The outdoor space is made up of a charming tiered garden adorned with climbing plants and towering trees, offering captivating valley views to guests. The star attraction is the private, fenced pool—a delightful oasis for relaxation and recreation. You can also dine outdoors on the many dining terraces or simply lounge in the sun and read your favourite book.

As the villages of Cortona and Camucia are each around 5km away, you are rurally located here but not isolated. These villages each offer their own characters; with Camucia providing larger shops and more amenities, while Cortona is known for its historic attractions and staggering views.

Further afield, you can drive out to other areas for day trips; such as Lake









Trasimeno, the city of Arezzo and the city of Perugia which is in neighbouring Umbria.

With so much to see and do nearby, you will not have to go far to keep everyone entertained.

Just a short distance from the residence, a variety of dining options and shops await you in the neighbouring quaint villages. These charming locales also feature organic farms, family-operated vineyards, beautiful gardens, and the impressive Castello di Montecchio Vesponi-an enchanting castle that serves as an excellent endpoint for a leisurely countryside stroll. Some nearby farms even offer guided horse treks and Italian cookery classes, providing engaging activities for visitors of all ages without venturing far.


For a more extensive selection of restaurants and a delightful place for a wander, a visit to Cortona, just 5km away, is highly recommended. This walled, hilltop town perched 500 meters high offers breathtaking views of the Val di Chiana. Cortona's rich history, originating from its Etruscan roots, is evident in its medieval and Renaissance architecture. Notable attractions include the Palazzo Casali, an 8th-century palace housing a local history museum, the original town gates, the Fortress del Girifalco constructed by Cosimo I de Medici, and captivating exhibitions at the Diocesano art museum.

For those craving the lively ambiance of a city, Arezzo, located 23km away by car, is an excellent choice. Steeped in history, Arezzo began as an ancient settlement over a millennium ago. Evolving into a vital trade route stop, the city witnessed numerous battles, necessitating the construction of its fortress, later rebuilt by the influential Medici family in 1500. Visitors can explore the fortress, now hosting art and history exhibitions, as well as a park within its grounds. Arezzo boasts additional landmarks, including The Basilica of Saint Francis, a Romanesque church showcasing Renaissance masterpieces by Piero della Francesca, and the National Museum of Medieval and Modern Art. The city's labyrinthine streets feature palaces, churches, cafes, restaurants, shops, and markets, offering a vibrant tapestry of historical and cultural delights at every turn.

If you wish to, you can even visit the enchanting city of Siena which is under an hour's drive away. 78km from the villa, Siena is one of Tuscany's must-visit cities and is a truly incredible medieval centre, packed with art galleries and ornate churches, including the famous Duomo.
