The heart of the home is the bright and airy living room, featuring an inviting L-shaped sofa, a fireplace, and a TV. Adjacent to this is a formal dining area adorned with an ornate mirror and a dazzling chandelier, centred around a table seating eight. The chic kitchen, equipped with modern gadgets and appliances, opens onto the garden, providing a farmhouse breakfast table and elegant marble countertops.

Villa Mazzavia accommodates 11 guests across six well-appointed bedrooms, offering diverse sleeping arrangements. Day trips to Lake Trasimeno, the city of Arezzo and the city of Perugia offer the change to get to know the different sides of Tuscany and Umbria.

Cortona is a beloved tourist spot which is a medieval gem. Perched 500 meters high, the walled village invites exploration of its historical treasures, including ancient churches, defensive fortifications and picturesque squares. The ascent to Cortona's elevated position rewards visitors with breathtaking vistas of the surrounding valleys. Just outside of the centre, you can also visit the fascinating Archaeological park which is packed with Roman and Etruscan ruins, monuments and tombs, you can also visit changing exhibitions on local history.

A short drive of 15km leads to Lake Trasimeno, a stunning lake offering a scenic escape with crystal-clear waters and charming lakeside towns. You can spend lazy days on the beaches or partake in boat trips around the lake, exploring its islands and indulging in water sports.

Nature enthusiasts can also relish walks in the Val di Chiana, a scenic valley with picturesque trails winding through the Tuscan countryside. The surrounding landscape, with its undulating hills and sprawling vineyards, provides the perfect backdrop for leisurely strolls and invigorating hikes.

Day trips open up avenues for exploration beyond the immediate vicinity. Delve into the world of winemaking with visits to local vineyards, where wine tastings and guided tours offer immersive experiences into the art of viticulture. Arezzo, a city rich in history, lies just 23km away, boasting architectural wonders, museums, and vibrant markets. Alternatively, the papal city of Assisi, approximately 75km away, is a cultural haven with its historic sites, including the Basilica of St. Francis. Whether you choose to immerse yourself in the authentic ambiance of nearby villages, unwind by the shores of Lake Trasimeno, explore the Val di Chiana, or embark on enriching day trips, Tuscany is a multifaceted destination, promising a holiday filled with diverse and memorable experiences for all ages.
